पाकिस्तान के प्रधानमंत्री ने नए साल के संदेश में 'करमीर' का राग अलापा

भारत और पाकिस्तान ने अपने परमाणु प्रतिष्ठानों की सूची एक-दूसरे को सौंपी



एजेंसी, नई दिल्ली। भारत और पाकिस्तान ने बुधवार को द्विपक्षीय समझौते के तहत अपने परमाणु प्रतिष्ठानों की सूची का अदान-प्रदान किया। यह समझौता दोनों देशों को एक-दूसरे के परमाणु ठिकानों पर हमला करने से बचता है। विदेश मंत्रालय ने एक बयान किया कि भारत और पाकिस्तान ने आज नई दिल्ली और इस्लामाबाद में राजनीतिक माध्यमों से एक साथ दोनों देशों के बीच परमाणु प्रतिष्ठानों और सुविधाओं पर हमले की निषेध समझौते के अंतर्गत शामिल परमाणु प्रतिष्ठानों और सुविधाओं की सूची एक-दूसरे को सौंपी। बयान में कहा गया है कि 31 दिसंबर 1988 को हस्ताक्षरित और 27 जनवरी 1991 को लागू हुए इस समझौते में अन्य बातों के साथ-साथ यह भी प्रारंभ होता है कि भारत और पाकिस्तान प्रत्येक केंद्रों द्वारा वर्ष की पहली जनवरी को अंतर्राष्ट्रीय शामिल परमाणु प्रतिष्ठानों और सुविधाओं के बारे में एक-दूसरे को सूचित करें। यह दोनों देशों के बीच ऐसी सूचियों का लगातार 34वां अदान-प्रदान को हुआ था।

In the new year, we will move towards a developed Rajasthan: Bhajan Lal Sharma

Jaipur: Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma has given an emotional message by writing a letter to the people of the state on Tuesday on the eve of New Year 2025. In his letter, the Chief Minister said that the year 2024 was full of many achievements and pride for our country and Rajasthan. Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, India registered its strong presence on the global stage. He said that this year, after a long struggle of 500 years, a grand temple of Lord Shri Ram was built in Ayodhya and the desire of crores of countrymen was fulfilled. The year 2024 was also full of achievements for Rajasthan. Sharma said that 2024 was also a year of achievements for Rajasthan. We received the gift of ERCP (PKC) link project pending for years this year. Also, the start of work on the Dewas project and the Yamuna Water Agreement



paved the way for the development of the state and a permanent solution to the water crisis. The Chief Minister said that as soon as the government was formed, we freed the youth from the curse of paper leak, ended the recruitment mafia system and successfully organized paper leak-free examinations. He said that for the first time, the government released a 2-year calendar of recruitment examinations and also provided employment to the youth through the Chief Minister's Employment Festival. Sharma said that to give impetus to the state's economy, we successfully organized the Rising Rajasthan Global Investment Summit, in which a record MoU of Rs 35 lakh crore was signed. This will give unprecedented impetus to the industrial development of the state. He said that Rajasthan has also become the country's leading state

in the field of solar energy and renewable energy. To fulfill the resolve of providing electricity to our farmer brothers during the day by the year 2027, the state government has signed MoUs worth Rs 2 lakh 24 thousand crore in the energy sector. Salesman was murdered and tried to make it look like a road accident, two accused arrested

Pratapgarh: Police has solved the case of the body of a person found in the jungle of Punga Talab in Thana Devgarh area about 10 days ago and arrested two accused Rupesh Chaudhary son Jagdish Chandra (33) resident Panch Imla Thana Pratapgarh and Deepak Kalal son Sunil (25) resident Achalpur Thana Suhagpura. The accused killed the salesman by beating him on suspicion of embezzlement of about 6.50 lakh rupees from the sales of the liquor shop and threw the body and bike in the jungle to make the murder look like an accident. SP Vineet Kumar Bansal said that on 20th December, on receiving information about a dead body lying in the jungle of Punga Talab, CO Dhariyavad Nanalal Salvi and SHO Devgarh Mishri Lal reached the spot with their squad. The dead body of an unknown person was found there and a bike was lying in a rain drain nearby. The unknown body was kept in the district hospital and the process of identification was started.

In the district hospital, Amar Singh, a resident of Kalyanpur Road, Dhariyavad police station, gave a report to the police that his uncle's son Kesar Singh was working as a salesman at a wine shop on Dhariyavad Road for about 6 months.



He was beaten up and his body and bike were thrown on the roadside in the forest to make the murder look like an accident. A case was registered on the report and investigation was started. Considering the seriousness of the incident, on the instructions of SP Basnal, CO Nana Ram and Thanadikari Mishri Lal along with team and FSL unit and forensic unit Banswara collected evidence from the spot. Two teams were formed at the police station level. The formed teams kept an eye on the suspicious persons. During the investigation, on 26 December, the suspect Deepak Kalal was detained and questioned psychologically. Deepak told that Kesar Singh was the sales man at his shop for 8 months. On 17 December, when the shop accounts were checked, it was found that Kesar Singh had embezzled about Rs 6.50 lakh from the sales, but Kesar Singh

was denying it. On the day of the incident, on 19 December, contractor Deepak Kalal, Rupesh Chaudhary and their other companions called Kesar Singh to Achalpur at night on the pretext of having a party to extract the truth from him regarding the money. There they beat him to death. To dispose of the body and make the murder look like an accident, the accused put Kesar Singh's body and his motorcycle in their Tata Sumo car and threw the body and the motorcycle at a turn in the Pugatalab forest on the Dhariawad-Pratapgarh road in such a way that it looked like an accident.

After the body of deceased Kesar Singh was found, the contractor accompanied the police during the operation on the spot so that no one doubts their plan. But the police kept an eye on the activities of the suspects after inspecting the spot and seeing the injuries on the body of deceased Kesar Singh and the circumstances, as it appeared to be a murder. On the basis of this information and technical evidence, Deepak Kalal and Rupesh Chaudhary were detained and the incident was disclosed after interrogation. The search for other accused in the case is on.

Centre suggests places for Manmohan Singh's memorial, options sent to his family

New Delhi: The central government has initiated the process to build a memorial for former Prime Minister Dr Manmohan Singh. Suggestions for potential sites have been shared with his family, who have been asked to select one location to commence the construction work. According to sources, around 1 to 1.5 acres of land near Rajghat, Rashtriya

Smriti Sthal, or Kisan Ghat has been proposed for the memorial. Officials from the Ministry of Urban Development have already inspected these areas. Under the new policy, land for the memorial can only be allocated to a trust. Hence, the formation of a trust is a prerequisite for starting the project. Once the trust is established, it will apply

for the land allocation, and an MoU will be signed with the Central Public Works Department (CPWD) for construction. There is also a possibility that the memorial may be located near Rajghat, where the final resting places of Jawaharlal Nehru, Indira Gandhi, Rajiv Gandhi, and Sanjay Gandhi are situated. The move comes days after the BJP and Congress were



Agency: "It Ends With Us" director Justin Baldoni sued The New York Times for libel on Tuesday over its story on allegations that he sexually harassed and sought to smear the reputation of the film's star, Blake Lively. The lawsuit seeking at least \$250 million was filed in Los Angeles Superior Court, the next major move in a growing story that has made major waves in Hollywood. It alleges the Times and Lively coordinated a smear campaign against Baldoni and his nine fellow plaintiffs. The Times stood by its reporting and said it plans to "vigorously

defend" against the lawsuit. The plaintiffs include the film's lead producer Jamey Heath, its production company Wayfarer Studios, and crisis communications expert Melissa Nathan, whose text message was quoted in the headline of the Dec. 21 Times story: "We Can Buy Anyone: Inside a Hollywood Smear Machine." Written by Megan Twohey, Mike McIntire and Julie Tate, the story was published just after Lively filed a legal complaint that is usually a predecessor to a lawsuit with the California Civil Rights Department over her alleged treatment.

Police from three different police stations arrested six criminals in an encounter

Noida: As the new year began in Noida, police from three different police stations arrested six criminals in an encounter late last night. Illegal weapons, stolen bikes without number plates and other stolen items were recovered from them. The first encounter took place between Phase-2 police station and a wanted criminal who stole RRUUs and other valuable equipment from mobile towers. According to the police, on January 1, Phase-2 Noida police station was checking at Kent RO intersection. During the checking, a person riding a bike without a number plate was signaled to stop, but he did not stop and started running fast towards Nimmvi Vihar. The police chased him. Seeing himself surrounded, the criminal opened fire on the police force with his weapon. In the retaliatory action taken by the police, the criminal Vikas alias Toi (24) was injured by a bullet. 1 country-made pistol .32

bore, 1 empty cartridge .32 bore, 1 live cartridge .32 bore and 1 stolen bike without a number plate have been recovered from the possession of the injured criminal. Police has told that Vikas alias Toi has a gang of stealing RRUUs of mobile towers. One of his associates Rashid has already been arrested. Vikas alias Toi has carried out several incidents of stealing RRUUs of mobile towers along with him. 18 cases of theft are registered against him in different police stations. In the second case, there was an encounter between the Phase-1 police station and the miscreant. Giving information, the police said that the Phase-1 police team was checking the dirty drain on the way coming from the roundabout. Then two persons were seen coming from the front on a motorcycle without a number plate. When the police stopped them for checking, they did not stop and turned the bike back and started running on the

track of the dirty drain going towards Delhi from behind Sector 14A. After going a little distance, the motorcycle slipped and fell and the miscreants opened fire on the police party with the illegal pistol they had with them. In the retaliatory action taken by the police, the miscreant Om (23) was injured by a bullet. The injured person's accomplice Sanjay Rai (22) had fled from the spot, who has been arrested during combing. 6 stolen mobile phones and a looted motorcycle have been recovered from the possession of the miscreants. In the third encounter, Ecotech-3 police station arrested three criminals in an encounter with the criminals who used to rob people by sitting in vehicles as passengers. 9500 rupees, a stolen motorcycle, 2 pistols of .315 bore, 2 live and 2 empty cartridges, 1 pistol of .32 bore, 1 live and 1 empty cartridge of .32 bore were recovered from their possession. Police has

told that on 1st January, Ecotech-3 police station was checking suspicious vehicles and persons near Pushta Road. Then three boys were seen coming from the front on a motorcycle. They did not stop and started firing at the police and running towards Nayagaon Allahabad on the motorcycle. Seeing the police coming near them, the boys turned the motorcycle and started running towards the dirt road. Seeing themselves surrounded, those boys once again fired at the police with the intention of killing them. In the retaliatory action of the police, all three miscreants were injured by bullets. The injured miscreants have given their names as Titu, Akash Gupta alias Chaman and Khalid. The injured are being sent to the hospital for treatment. Information about other criminal history of the accused is being collected. Police has told that the miscreants had looted the driver of an Ertiga car at night on 28th December.

"Hell-Bent On Carnage": 10 Killed As

Pickup Truck Rams Crowd In New Orleans

Agency: At least 10 people are feared dead and 30 suffered injuries after a pickup truck ploughed into a crowd in the southern US city of New Orleans on New Year's Day. Witnesses said the driver of the truck also fired at the crowd and exchanged gunfire with the police. Officials said a crowd

was celebrating when the pickup truck drove into it at high speed at the intersection of Canal and Bourbon Street in a part of the city known as the French Quarter. While the police said the driver of the pickup truck was "hell-bent on creating carnage and the damage that he did," Police Superintendent Anne Kirkpatrick said. Although the incident was not being treated as a terror attack, Ms Kirkpatrick said the truck had been driven at "very high speed" and in a "very intentional" manner. Louisiana Governor Jeff Landry described the incident as a "horrific act of violence." Emergency authorities said the incident took place at approximately 3:15 am local time, news agency AFP reported.

The 8th District is currently working a mass casualty incident involving a vehicle that drove into a large crowd on Canal and Bourbon Street. There are 30 injured patients that have been transported by NOEMS and 10 fatalities. Public safety partners are responding on scene," New Orleans' emergency preparedness campaign NOLA Ready said on its website. Police said the driver tried to hit "as many people" as possible and two police personnel were also shot and wounded. "This man, this perpetrator, he fired on our officers from his vehicle when he crashed his vehicle. Two of our officers have been shot. They are stable... He was hell-bent on creating the carnage and the damage that he did," Police Superintendent Anne Kirkpatrick said. Although the incident was not being treated as a terror attack, Ms Kirkpatrick said the truck had been driven at "very high speed" and in a "very intentional" manner. Louisiana Governor Jeff Landry described the incident as a "horrific act of violence." Emergency authorities said the incident took place at approximately 3:15 am local time, news agency AFP reported. At that hour, the French Quarter, renowned for its bars, restaurants and jazz history, would have been packed with revellers. CBS News television reported witnesses saying the truck rammed into the crowd before its driver jumped out and started exchanging gunfire with police. A white truck crashed through a barricade "at a high rate of speed," witnesses Jim and Nicole Mowrer said. "Once it was past us, we did hear gunfire, saw police running that direction... Once the gunfire stopped, we stayed in the alcove until the gunfire stopped, came out into the street, and came across a lot of -- several people who had been hit, (we) wanted to see what we could do to help," Nicole Mowrer was quoted as saying in the AFP report. New Orleans is one of the most visited destinations in the United States and the attack came shortly before the city hosts a major football game, known as the Sugar Bowl, featuring teams from the University of Georgia and



Notre Dame.

The city police department had announced staffing at "100 percent, with an additional 300 officers assisting from partner law enforcement agencies," including on horseback and using unmarked units. The iconic French Quarter listed special deals for New Year's, including LGBTQ parties and drag cabaret close to where the incident took place.

The incident comes days after five people were killed in a similar car-ramming attack in Germany. More than 200 people were also injured in the December 20 attack in the eastern city of Magdeburg, which was allegedly carried out by a man of Saudi origin. The attacker has been arrested and police are investigating whether he is mentally ill.
