

# Union Budget 2025: What Is Halwa Ceremony? Why Is It Important?

**Agency:** The Union Budget of India is one of the most anticipated events of the year, and it is presented annually by the Finance Minister in Parliament. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman will present the Union Budget on 1 February 2025, marking the second budget of the Modi government's third term and Nirmala Sitharaman's eighth consecutive budget presentation, including one interim budget.

While the Union Budget itself is always in the spotlight, there's a pre-budget tradition that garners much attention. The Halwa Ceremony is a pre-budget ritual held by the Finance Ministry of India, usually about 9-10 days before the Union Budget is presented in the Parliament. The ceremony involves the preparation of halwa in a large kadhai (wok) in the

Finance Ministry's kitchen, located in the North Block in New Delhi. The Finance Minister officiates by stirring the halwa and then it is served to the officials and staff members involved in the budget preparation process.

**Why Is The Halwa Ceremony Important?** The Halwa Ceremony is more than just a cultural or festive event. The ceremony not only celebrates the hard work before entering the final stage of the Budget preparation process. It symbolizes the start of the lock-in period, which is crucial for ensuring the confidentiality and security of the Union Budget. After the ceremony, all staff members involved in drafting the Budget enter a period where they are quarantined within the Finance Ministry, specifically in the North Block. This lock-in period

involves several measures to ensure that no details about the Budget leak before it is presented in Parliament. The most significant action is the confiscation of mobile phones and other communication devices from the officials. No communication with the outside world is allowed, and the officials are cut off from external access. This stringent process helps maintain secrecy and prevents any unauthorized leak of sensitive information regarding the Budget. The lock-in period continues until the Budget documents receive approval from the Prime Minister and are ready for printing. The printing of the Budget itself is done in the basement of the North Block, which is a highly secured area, ensuring that no one outside the core team has access to the final drafts before the official Budget announcement.

**Historical Significance of the Halwa Ceremony** The Halwa Ceremony has been a part of the Union Budget tradition for many years, though its exact origins remain unclear. However, its importance grew significantly after the Budget leak in 1950, which exposed sensitive details of the Budget before its official release. Following this incident, the printing press for the Budget was moved from Rashtrapati Bhavan to Minto Road, and eventually, to the North Block basement, where it has remained the

permanent printing press for the Budget since 1980. The Union Budget 2025 is scheduled to be presented by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on 1 February 2025, at 11:00 AM. This will mark another important chapter in the government's ongoing financial plans and initiatives for the nation. As the second Budget of the Modi government's third term, the nation will be watching closely for announcements related to economic reforms, growth strategies, and social welfare programs.



## 'Main Vidhayak Ka Beta Hoon': AAP MLA Amanatullah Khan Son Threatens Delhi Police over Challan

**Agency:** AAP MLA Amanatullah Khan's son, Mohammad Anas, allegedly threatened Delhi Police after being stopped for riding a bike with a modified silencer and issuing a Challan. He said, "Main vidhayak ka beta hoon", according to the Police when they stopped him for using modified silencer in his bike. Delhi Police on Wednesday issued a challan and seized a Royal Enfield Bullet motorcycle with a modified silencer, allegedly driven by Mohammad Anas, the son of AAP MLA Amanatullah Khan. The bike, with registration number DL14SL4388, was black in color and equipped with a modified silencer which was creating loud noise and violating traffic laws. According to FIR, the incident took place at around 8:30 PM near Nafes Road, Batla House, when police were patrolling the area ahead of Republic Day. According to officials, two boys were riding the bike in a reckless manner, driving in a zigzag pattern, and coming from the wrong side. The police stopped them for violating traffic rules, but the situation escalated when



one of the boys, identified as Mohammad Anas, claimed to be the son of MLA Amanatullah Khan.

"He told us, 'Main vidhayak ka beta hoon' (I am the son of an MLA) and questioned why we were stopping his bike, alleging it was because it had the Aam Aadmi Party symbol on it," an officer said. Boy reportedly refused to produce a driving license or registration certificate (RC) and misbehaved with the police personnel. When asked to cooperate, he called someone and claimed he was his father, Amanatullah Khan, who allegedly spoke rudely to the police over the phone. The situation intensified, and Anas, along with the other boy, abandoned the bike at the spot and fled without providing their names or

addresses. The police took possession of the Royal Enfield Bullet, which had been fitted with an illegal silencer, and registered a case under multiple sections of the Motor Vehicles Act, including driving without a license or RC, modifying the silencer, not wearing helmets, reckless driving, and misbehavior, according to Police. The seized bike was deposited in the police storeroom, and the incident was recorded by an officer on his mobile phone as evidence. The police have assured that further investigation is underway to verify the identity of the boys, and they will be informed about the court date after verification.

## 6 critical in huge blast at ordnance factory in Maharashtra's Bhandara



**At least 6 injured in massive blast in Ordnance factory**

**Agency:** A powerful explosion was reported at an ordnance factory in Maharashtra today. According to initial reports, at least 5 to 6 people have been critically injured. ## US judge blocks Trump's birthright citizenship order: Blatantly unconstitutional

**Agency:** A US federal judge has blocked President Donald Trump from implementing an executive order denying the right to automatic birthright citizenship in the country, news agency Reuters reported on Thursday. The judge called the order "blatantly unconstitutional". Honouring the request of four Democratic-led states, US District Judge John Coughenour issued a temporary order restraining the Trump administration from implementing the order. Trump, who took office for a second time on January 20, had signed the order on Monday, which was his first day in office. The federal judge's order came just a day after Democratic-led states and civil rights groups filed a bunch of lawsuits challenging Trump's bid to roll back birthright citizenship in an early attempt by his opponents to block his agenda in court. After his inauguration on Monday, Trump, a Republican, ordered US agencies to refuse to recognise



the citizenship of children born in the US if neither their mother or father is a US citizen or legal permanent resident. "I have been on the bench for over four decades. I cannot remember another case where the question presented was as clear as this one is," US District Judge John Coughenour told a Justice Department attorney. "This is a blatantly unconstitutional order," the judge added. The decision on Thursday prevents the Trump administration from taking steps to implement the executive order for 14 days. During this time, the parties will submit further arguments about the order's merits. Judge Coughenour has scheduled a hearing on February 6 to decide whether to block the order for a longer period as the case

## ICC Chairperson Jay Shah Inducted Into World Cricket Connects Advisory Board

**Agency:** The ICC chairperson Jay Shah has been inducted into a newly instituted World Cricket Connects Advisory Board, an independent group that will discuss the many challenges and opportunities in the sport during a discussion at the Lord's on June 7 and 8. Former BCCI secretary Shah, regarded as the most influential man in world cricket, had taken over as the ICC chairperson on December 1 last year, and his presence at the 'World Cricket Connects' forum is a chance for him to convey his ideas to a wider stage. Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC), the custodian of the laws of cricket, on Tuesday announced that World Cricket Connects, the event to bring together the most prominent thinkers, voices and influencers in the game, will take place once again this year. "The forum, which proved hugely popular in bringing together influential people from across all aspects of cricket in its inaugural year in 2024, will be held ahead of the ICC World Test Championship Final between South Africa and Australia," said MCC in release. The first event saw around 120 leading voices in cricket gather in the Long Room



## 10 opposition MPs suspended following ruckus in Waqf board JPC meet

**New Delhi:** 10 opposition MPs were suspended for a day on Friday following a ruckus during the Joint Parliamentary Committee meeting on the Waqf Amendment Bill 2024.

The suspended MPs include Kalyan Banerjee, Md. Jawaid, A Raja, Asaduddin Owaisi, Nasir Hussain, Mohibullah, M. Abdullah, Arvind Sawant, Md. Anas, and Imran Masood.

Following the meeting, TMC MP Kalyan Banerjee, accused the JPC chairman Jagdambika Pal of not listening to the opposition and conducting the proceeding like a "jamindari."

"After 21st January late session, chairman informed the members that meeting will be held on 24th and 25th January. Other members protested and wrote a letter. We request to schedule the meeting after 30th or 31st but the chairman did not listen to us. So we came by postponing all our programmes. Yesterday midnight we got the message that there is a change of agenda, there won't be a clockwise discussion but meeting will be held on 24th and 27th

don't give any respect to the opposition members. This JPC has become a farce," he added. "The chairman should also understand how many days the earlier JPCs on Waqf and other issues have functioned. There were a larger number of sittings. So, I don't think we should hurry. We should discuss in detail and present a comprehensive report. Instead, what BJP and the government are trying to do is push the JPC to submit the report only to gain an advantage in the Delhi elections," Congress MP Nasir Hussain said.

Meanwhile, BJP MP Jagdambika Pal, injuring himself in the process.

"However, in front of Mirwaiz, these people created a ruckus, misbehaved, and acted against parliamentary democracy," he added.

This is not the first time that a JPC meeting on the Waqf Amendment Bill 2024 was concluded in a ruckus.
