UN report exposes Yunus on attacks on Hindus in Bangladesh

Agency: Though Muhammad Yunus, the Chief Advisor to the interim government in Bangladesh, repeatedly discarded incidents of violence against the Hindus as mere "exaggerated propaganda", a fact-finding report by the United Nations Human Rights Office debunked his claims by providing evidence of violent mob attacks, including assaults on places of worship of Hindus. Incidentally, the fact-finding team was sent at the invitation of Yunus' interim government. After violent protests in Bangladesh forced now-ousted PM Sheikh Hasina to flee on August 5, 2024, Hindus, making up about 8% of the country's 17-crore population, faced deadly attacks, with their homes, businesses, and religious sites vandalised. A week after Hasina's ouster in August 2024, India Today Digital scanned through reports and spoke to sources in Bangladesh to report that there were over 200 instances of attacks, including five killings, on minority Hindus in three days of chaos after the fall of the Sheikh Hasina regime in Bangladesh. However, even as Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and then-US President-elect Donald Trump criticised the attacks on Hindus

in Bangladesh, Yunus downplayed the violence against Hindus, describing it as "exaggerated propaganda" with political motives aimed at destabilising the nation. The UN report released on February 12 also noted that violent mob attacks on Hindu minorities in Bangladesh began even before Hasina was forced to flee to India. It also revealed that, along with the Hindus, Ahmadiyya Muslims and indigenous groups in the Chittagong Hill Tracts, were subjected to similar atrocities in Bangladesh. "During and after the protests, members of the Hindu community, Ahmadiyya Muslims and indigenous groups in the Chittagong Hill Tracts, were also subject to violent attacks by mobs, including burning of homes and some attacks on places of worship," said the report in its summary. Hindus and other minority communities earlier claimed that the Yunus-led interim government hadn't protected them adequately. Hindus in Bangladesh faced over 2,000 attack incidents after Hasina was forced to flee in August 2024, news agency Associated Press in November reported, quoting the Bangladesh Hindu Buddhist Christian Unity Council, a minority rights group. Between November 26, 2024, and January 25,

2025, "76 cases of incidents of attacks against Hindus have been reported in Bangladesh. Since August, reports have cited deaths of 23 Hindus and 152 incidents of attack on Hindu temples in Bangladesh," according to Kirti Vardhan Singh, the minister of state (MoS) of the Ministry of External Affairs, said in the Parliament last week. The UN report has also pointed out the specific places in Bangladesh where violence against Hindus took place. "According to information submitted to OHCHR, in Burashardubi, Hatibandha, Lalmonirhat three temples were attacked and set ablaze, along with the looting of approximately 20 houses, reflecting significant levels of community unrest," noted the UN report. "In the aftermath of the former [Hasina] Government's fall, widespread attacks were reported against Hindu homes, businesses, and places of worship, especially in rural and historically tense areas such as Thakurgaon, Lalmonirhat, and Dinajpur, but also in other places such as Sylhet, Khulna, and Rangpur," the report noted. The incidents of violence against Hindus included property destruction, arson, and physical threats, exacerbated by inadequate police action, indicating

systemic impunity and possible political motives, the report revealed. The report also revealed that these attacks on Hindus were driven by "religious and ethnic discrimination, revenge against Awami League supporters among minorities, local communal disputes over land, and interpersonal issues". "Some Jamaat-e-Islami and BNP supporters, members and local leaders were also involved in revenge violence and attacks on distinct religious and indigenous groups," noted the report. The UN report titled, 'Human Rights Violations and Abuses related to the Protests of July and August 2024 in Bangladesh', that was conducted at "the invitation of the Interim Government of Bangladesh", has thus exposed Muhammad Yunus' claims of "exaggerated propaganda". Earlier in November 2024, a report by Transparency International Bangladesh (TIB) revealed that minorities, including Hindus, had suffered in the first 100 days of the Muhammad Yunus government in Bangladesh. The report cited 2,010 incidents of communal violence under the post-Hasina regime and the lack of effort to identify and punish the perpetrators.

Waqf Report Storm In Parliament, Amit Shah says no objection to dissent notes

Agency: Both houses of Parliament witnessed a massive showdown between the NDA and opposition MPs over the report of the joint committee on the Waqf (Amendment) Bill, 2024, which was tabled on Thursday. Both the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha witnessed protests by the opposition, with MPs claiming that portions of dissent notes were removed from the final report. In the Lok Sabha, the report on the Bill, which aims to streamline registration of Waqf properties, was tabled by Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) chairperson and BJP MP Jagadambika Pal amid chants of 'Jai Shri Ram'. However, the proceedings were marred by opposition protests as MPs trooped to the Well of the House and raised slogans. In a bid to pacify the protesting MPs, Union Home Minister Amit Shah said the government had no objection if the dissent notes were added. "Some opposition members have objected, stating that their disputes have not been fully included. On behalf of my party, I request that the opposition's disputes be appropriately incorporated into the parliamentary procedure. My party has no objection to this," Shah said. In the Rajya Sabha, the report on the bill was tabled by Rajya Sabha MP Medha Kulkarni and was accepted by the House. The opposition eventually staged a walkout of the Rajya Sabha during the discussion on the report. Leader of Opposition and Congress chief Mallikarjun Kharge said the opposition would not accept "fake reports" that "bulldoze our views". The Congress chief demanded that the report be sent back to the Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) and presented again. "In the JPC report, many members have their dissent report. It is not right to remove those notes and bulldoze our views. This is anti-democracy... We will never accept such fake reports. If the report does not have dissenting views, it should be sent back and presented again," Kharge said. In a show of unity among the opposition, several INDIA bloc MPs also backed Kharge. Sena (UBT)



MP Arvind Sawant claimed that clause-by-clause discussions were never held in the meetings of the JPC. "Because of this, we gave a dissent note. They have removed the dissent note we gave," he said. Countering Kharge's claims, Union Minister Kiren Rijiju said the dissent notes were attached in the appendix of the report and accused the opposition of misleading the House. "There is no deletion or removal from the report... The members of the Opposition are creating an unnecessary issue," he said. Hitting out at the opposition, Union Minister and BJP president JP Nadda said "some were trying to fight the Indian state" - a seeming reference to Rahul Gandhi's controversial remark last year. Last year, Gandhi had said that the Congress was not only fighting the BJP and the RSS, but the "Indian state" as well. The legislation proposes a complete overhaul of the governance of Waqf boards, which oversee properties donated for religious and charitable purposes by the Muslim community. Among the key provisions of the bill are the inclusion of at least two non-Muslim members on state Waqf boards and arbitration by a government official to decide whether a property is Waqf property or not. The final report of the Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) was presented to Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla on January 30 after months-long deliberations. The amended revised bill was adopted by the panel on January 29. While 14 amendments proposed by the ruling NDA members were approved, the changes suggested by the opposition MPs were rejected.

PM Modi arrives in US, to hold high-stake talks with President Trump

Agency: Prime Minister Narendra Modi arrived in Washington, D.C., to a warm welcome amid chilly weather. He will meet President Donald Trump during his official working visit to the US. This is Modi's first visit to the US since the inauguration of Trump who assumed office on January 20. Modi will be the fourth world leader to meet Trump in his second presidential term, the previous ones being Israel Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe and Jordan King Abdullah. This is also the earliest an Indian Prime Minister has met with a US President after his inauguration to the White House. Modi's first meeting upon landing was with Tulsi Gabbard, the Director of National Intelligence who called on the PM.

"Met USA's Director



of National Intelligence, @ TulsiGabbard in Washington DC. Congratulated her on her confirmation. Discussed various aspects of the India-USA friendship, of which she's always been a strong votary," the Prime Minister said on X. An official statement said Prime Minister fondly recalled his earlier interactions with Gabbard. "The discussions touched on enhancing bilateral intelligence cooperation,

particularly in counter-terrorism, cybersecurity, emerging threats, and strategic intelligence sharing. They also exchanged views on regional and global developments of mutual interest, reaffirming their commitment to a secure, stable, and rules-based international order," the communique from PMO said. The much anticipated Modi Trump meeting will have on the agenda

defence cooperation and the sticking issues pertaining to Trump's trade tariff raises and deportation of illegal immigrants. While Trump is likely to demand fair trade relations having called India as a very big abuser on tariffs, PM Modi will likely flag the recent mistreatment of 104 Indian deportees sent back home in chains, triggering domestic outrage and calls from the Opposition to demand dignity for the immigrants who are not criminals.

Modi and Trump have in the past shared good personal rapport with Trump once describing the Prime Minister as the "nicest person." Prime Minister Modi has also mentioned "friend Trump" warmly. India will look to strike a balance on trade tariffs with the US having already slashed import duties on several products the US exports to India.

Adani withdraws from Sri Lanka power project amid mounting scrutiny

Agency: Adani Green Energy, the renewable arm of billionaire Gautam Adani's conglomerate, has withdrawn from two proposed wind power projects in Sri Lanka, following the island nation's new government deciding to renegotiate tariffs.

"Adani Green Energy has conveyed its Board's decision to respectfully withdraw from further engagement in the renewable energy (RE) wind energy project and two transmission projects in Sri Lanka," the firm said in a statement. The company was to invest a total of USD 1 billion in generating electricity from wind at two projects and laying transmitting lines to take it to users. The plan came under the scrutiny of the newly elected administration under President Anura Kumara Dissanayake who wanted to reduce electricity costs. "However,

we remain committed to Sri Lanka and are open to future collaboration if the government of Sri Lanka so desires" AGEL said. Adani group, however, continues to be invested in a USD 700 million terminal project at Sri Lanka's largest port in Colombo. AEGL was originally supposed to develop two wind farms with a total capacity of 484 megawatts in Sri Lanka's Mannar and Pooneryn regions, with an investment of USD 740 million. The project, slated for completion by mid-2026, had a rough start with opposition from environmental groups and legal challenges in Sri Lanka's Supreme Court over ecological concerns. In May last year, Sri Lanka's previous government agreed to purchase power from the proposed Adani wind plant at USD 0.0826 per kilowatt-hour. The new government began investigating the



contract following an indictment against the Adani group founder chairman Gautam Adani and his key associates in a US Court for allegedly paying bribes to Indian officials to secure contracts to supply renewable energy in the country. In January, the new administration revoked Adani's power purchase and began investigations. Thereafter it opted to review and renegotiate the terms to bring the cost below USD 0.06 per unit. Unable to meet the demand, the Adani group has withdrawn from the project. The group conveyed its decision to the Sri Lankan government on February 12 saying it learnt that a Cabinet-appointed negotiations committee and project committee would be constituted to renegotiate the project proposal. The Board of AGEL deliberated on the issue and decided that while the company fully respects the sovereign rights of Sri Lanka and its choices, it would respectfully withdraw from the said project.

Dalai Lama Given Z-category Security Cover Following Threat Intel



Agency: New Delhi: Tibetan spiritual leader Dalai Lama has been given Z-category security from the Union Home Ministry after an intel report regarding threat perception was received by the agencies, sources said on Thursday. The Home Ministry has granted Z-category security to Tibetan spiritual leader Dalai Lama based on an IB threat report. The MHA has provided VIP security,

ensuring Z-category protection for the Dalai Lama across India, news agency IANS quoted official sources.

Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) have put an end to all the speculations around Virat Kohli and have named Rajat Patidar as their skipper for the eighteenth season of the Indian Premier League (IPL). The 31-year-old player who hails from Indore, Madhya Pradesh is a part of RCB's core group for a very long time. It was speculated that Virat Kohli was the frontrunner to lead the franchise in the upcoming season, but it is Patidar who has been bestowed with the leadership duties and will have the onus on himself to end Royal Challengers Bengaluru's trophy drought. Rajat will have an herculean task ahead of him, but he will hope to replicate what Smriti Mandhana did with RCB in 2024.

Former RCB skipper Virat Kohli too lauded Rajat Patidar with a special video message. Kohli praised Patidar for all the stellar performances that he delivered for the franchise and assured the RCB



skipper that the entire team will be behind him. Royal Challengers Bengaluru retained Patidar for Rs. 11 crore ahead of the upcoming eighteenth season. Patidar was Royal Challengers Bengaluru's second retention after former skipper Virat Kohli. The Bengaluru-based franchise retained Kohli, Patidar and Yash Dayal ahead of the IPL mega auctions.

Indore-based cricketer Rajat Patidar debuted in the IPL back in 2021. Patidar has always been a part of the Royal Challengers Bengaluru franchise and has scored a total of 799 runs from 24 innings and 27 IPL matches. The Royal Challengers Bengaluru captain has an average of 34.74 and has scored all these runs with a strike rate of 158.85.

US to deport 2nd batch of illegal immigrants to India

Agency: The US will soon deport another batch of 170-180 illegal immigrants to India. This would be the second batch of immigrants to be deported by the US government. These are

individuals who entered the US through "donkey routes" or other illegal means, spending lakhs of rupees, and have been staying in the US for the last one to three years. Though official confirmation from Indian officials is awaited, the US administration sources have said that the deportation could take place this week only. Earlier, the first batch had landed at the Shri Guru Ramdas Ji International Airport in Amritsar. However, no confirmation yet on where the second batch will land. The US action comes as Prime Minister Narendra Modi is in Washington to hold wide-ranging talks with President Donald Trump. Earlier this month, 104 Indian migrants were deported from the US. While 30 of the deportees were from Punjab, 33 each are from Haryana and Gujarat, three each from Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, and two from Chandigarh. Earlier, a US military plane C-17 was used to bring back the illegal immigrants. The deportees are expected to be allowed to go home following verification and background checks. Police will focus on identifying any deportee with a criminal record.
