
# Ishan Kishan celebrations were aimed at India selectors and Rohit Sharma

**Agency:** Ishan Kishan was in beast mode on Sunday, lighting up the Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium in Hyderabad with a blistering 106\* off just 47 balls. His explosive knock powered Sunrisers Hyderabad to a commanding 44-run victory over Rajasthan Royals. However, Kishan's journey to this moment is even more compelling than his stunning century on debut for Sunrisers Hyderabad in the IPL. Around this time last year, he was dropped from the BCCI's central contracts, with selectors and top officials believing he wasn't prioritising red-ball cricket. Once regarded as one of India's top three wicketkeeper-batters alongside Rishabh Pant and Sanju Samson, Kishan found himself on the sidelines, left to reflect and rebuild. But on Sunday, in the vibrant



Orange jersey, he let his bat do the talking. His unbeaten 47-ball innings, laced with 11 boundaries and six sixes, was a statement of intent. As he reached his century, Kishan, who was bought for Rs 11.25 crore at the auction, celebratory roar sent a clear message—he was back. "Kishan's celebration for three figures today, that was a celebration maybe (aimed) for Mumbai, maybe to the chairman of selectors, maybe to Rohit Sharma, maybe to the whole of India, maybe to the whole of the world, just to say, 'Look I'm a decent player,'" Vaughan told Cricbuzz.

"He's a wonderfully balanced player, with the break of the wrist to just flick the ball. He's got that great shot on the outside with anything short. I'd love to be the chairman of selectors for India. I mean, the selection meetings would be



long because you've got so many players to talk about and you'd be a naughty step as a selector because you're saying to someone 'sorry, you're not even in the top five at the minute,'" he said. "The talent pool in Indian cricket is monstrous and the only way that you can get in, the only way that you can push yourself into that set-up is by doing remarkable things. ## DK Shivakumar says his 'Constitution change' remark misquoted: What's the row?

**Agency:** Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar found himself at the centre of a political firestorm over his alleged remarks on "changing the Constitution" to accommodate religion-based reservations. While the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) accused the Congress leader of undermining constitutional values, Shivakumar hit back, calling it a deliberate misinterpretation of his words to mislead the public.

Addressing reporters in Bengaluru on Monday, Shivakumar strongly refuted the allegations and accused the BJP of running a false propaganda campaign against him. "I have never said that I will change the Constitution. The BJP is deliberately twisting my words and spreading false propaganda. I will take legal action against this," he said.

The hike in the salaries and pensions was notified in exercise of the powers granted under the Salary, Allowances and Pension of Members of Parliament Act on the basis of the Cost Inflation Index specified in the Income Tax Act of 1961.

Shivakumar also said that his words had been deliberately distorted. "I never said we are going to change the Constitution. I only mentioned that



## Demolition begins at Mumbai studio where Kunal Kamra mocked Eknath Shinde

**Agency:** Amid mounting political outrage over stand-up comedian Kunal Kamra's recent remarks targeting Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation workers on Monday arrived at Mumbai's Habitat Studio and began demolishing portions of the venue, citing rule violations.

The exact nature of these alleged violations remains unclear, with no official details provided by BMC authorities at the time of filing this report.

However, several civic body officials were seen entering the venue, located in the Unicontinental Hotel in Khar area, with hammers. The controversy erupted after Kamra, known for his sharp criticism of the ruling dispensation, used a parody of a popular Hindi song to describe Shinde's 2022 rebellion against his former boss, Uddhav Thackeray.

A clip from his recent show shared by Kamra himself showed him singing a spoof song from the Bollywood film Dil To Pagal Hai, referring to "a leader from Thane," making remarks about Shinde's physical appearance and his equation with Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. However, Kamra did not explicitly name Shinde in the clip. The video sparked a massive controversy and chaos soon erupted. The comments

made by Kamra in the video angered leaders from the Shiv Sena (Shinde faction) and they vandalised a studio and Hotel Unicontinental in Mumbai's Khar area on Sunday. They claimed that the video was shot at this location. Also, 11 Shiv Sena (Shinde faction) workers, including Rahul Kanal, were arrested for vandalism.

Hours after the row, the comedian responded with a short four-word post. "The only way forward", Kamra wrote on X with a photo of himself holding a small copy of the Constitution.

## Sensex reclaims 78,000 after 1,100-point rally, Nifty ends above 23,600

**Agency:** Benchmark stock market indices closed higher on Monday after seeing a bull run that led to Sensex's best performance in past few months. The S&P BSE Sensex surged 1,078.87 points to close at 77,984.38, while the NSE Nifty50 added 323.55 points to end at 23,673.95.

Aditya Gaggar, Director of Progressive Shares, said that the bulls strengthened their hold on the market for the sixth consecutive day, with Nifty50 continuing to compound its gains. All the sectors ended in green, with Banking Indices leading the charge, followed by the Realty and Energy sectors. Mid and Smallcap stocks largely mirrored the movement of the Frontline Index.

## Centre notifies 24% hike in salaries for MPs and ex-Parliamentarians

**Agency:** The central government on Monday notified a 24 per cent hike in the salaries, daily allowances and pensions of MPs and former Parliamentarians, with effect from April 1, 2023. The notification, issued by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, also increased the daily allowances for sitting members and pension and additional pension for every year of service in excess of five years for former members. Sitting MPs will now receive a monthly salary of Rs 1.24 lakh as against Rs 1 lakh they received earlier. The daily allowances have been increased

from Rs 2,000 to Rs 2,500, according to the notification.

The pension for former MPs has been hiked from Rs 25,000 per month to Rs 31,000 per month, it said. The additional pension for every year of service in excess of five years has been increased from Rs 2,000 per month to Rs 2,500 per month, the notification said.

When asked whether the media had misreported his statement, Shivakumar clarified: "No, the media is not at fault. The BJP twisted my words and unnecessarily dragged my name into this."

The Deputy Chief Minister also accused the BJP of creating a diversion to cover up its failures. "The central government failed in its budget. Since the budget had nothing substantial, the BJP is trying to distract people with baseless issues.

This is part of a larger political conspiracy against me and the Congress party," he said.
