




रेड 2 ने बॉक्स ऑफिस पर दूसरे दिन भी किया कमाल, द भूतनी का काम-तमाम

Ban on firecrackers will continue in Delhi-NCR : Supreme Court

New Delhi: The ban on firecrackers will continue in Delhi-NCR. The Supreme Court has directed UP, Rajasthan and Haryana to implement the ban on firecrackers in Delhi-NCR. The bench headed by Justice AS Oka warned that contempt proceedings will be initiated if the order is not implemented. The court directed the three state governments to fully implement the environmental law and issue guidelines to ban the sale, storage and even online delivery of firecrackers. The court directed these state governments to set up



machinery to effectively implement the order banning firecrackers. Earlier on April 3, the Supreme Court had justified the complete ban on firecrackers in Delhi-NCR. The Supreme Court said that until it is proven that green crackers cause negligible pollution, there is no justification for changing the old ban order.

Ukraine carried out drone attacks in Russia overnight, also targeted Moscow

Moscow: Ukraine attacked Russia with unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) all night. Ukraine also targeted parts of the capital Moscow. Russia claims that Ukraine's drone attacks were thwarted. Russia's state news agency TASS gave this information quoting the Russian Defense Ministry. The Defense Ministry said that the country's air defense systems intercepted and destroyed 105 Ukrainian fixed-wing UAVs in Russian regions. According to the Russian Defense Ministry, 32 drones were destroyed in the Bryansk region, 22 in the Voronezh region, 19 in the Moscow region, 10 in the Penza region, nine in the Kaluga region, six in the Belgorod region, two each

night. Of these, 19 were in the Moscow region. According to TASS, from 09 pm Moscow time (06 pm GMT) on May 05 to 4 am on May 6, air defense systems intercepted and shot down 105 Ukrainian fixed-wing UAVs in Russian regions. According to the Russian Defense Ministry, 32 drones were destroyed in the Bryansk region, 22 in the Voronezh region, 19 in the Moscow region, 10 in the Penza region, nine in the Kaluga region, six in the Belgorod region, two each

in the Lipetsk and Samara regions and one each in the Vladimir, Kursk and Rostov regions. Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyanin said the debris of one of the drones heading towards the capital fell on the Kashirskoye Highway. Initial information suggests no serious damage. Following this, temporary restrictions have been imposed on the capital's Vnukovo, Domodedovo, Sheremetyevo and Zhukovsky airports. Restrictions are

already in place at airports in Kaluga, Volgograd, Saratov, Samara, Ivanovo, Nizhny Novgorod, Yaroslavl, Kazan and Nizhnekamsk. According to US news channel ABC News, flights were suspended at four airports in Moscow in view of Ukraine's aggressive stance. These attacks were carried out amid preparations for the Victory Day celebrations to be held on May 09 in Moscow. Chinese President Xi Jinping and other world leaders friendly to the Kremlin are expected to attend the ceremony. Victory Day will celebrate the victory of the Soviet Union over Nazi Germany in 1945. During this, a grand military parade will be held in Moscow. President Vladimir Putin has also invited Belarus President Alexander Lukashenko, Venezuela President Nicolas Maduro and Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva to attend it. Putin had announced a unilateral ceasefire from May 08 to 11 on the occasion of Victory Day last month.

» INLD's Matka breaking protest against Punjab government today

Rohtak: INLD's National General Secretary Captain Inder Singh said that Punjab government has not done any good work by stopping Haryana's share of water. This is against humanity. He said that water crisis is continuously increasing in Haryana and in such a situation, Prime Minister Narendra Modi should immediately talk to Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann and get Haryana its share of water. INLD's

National General Secretary Captain Inder Singh was addressing the meeting of party workers in Kalanaur and Rohtak on Tuesday. He said that on May 7, thousands of workers under the leadership of INLD State President Rampal Majra will do Matka breaking protest against Punjab government from Mansarovar Park to Mini Secretariat and a memorandum will be submitted to the Prime Minister to get Haryana's

share of water. On this occasion, District Incharge Balwant Singh Maina, Dr. Nafe Singh Lahli, Advocate Krishna Kaushik and Advocate Vinod Ahlawat said that Punjab Government is adopting a dictatorial attitude by stopping Haryana's water, which will prove to be the last nail in the coffin of Aam Aadmi Party in future. Jaipur/Khairthal-Tijara: Governor Haribhai Bagde held a review meeting of district level officers in Rico Guest House Auditorium Bhiwadi on Tuesday. While reviewing the progress of various public welfare schemes of the Central and State Government, he directed the officials that no eligible person should be deprived of the benefits of the schemes and wide publicity of the schemes should be ensured, so that their benefits can reach the last person of the society and the real needy class can be empowered. He directed to ensure timely, effective and result-oriented implementation of the schemes. Governor Bagde conducted a detailed review of the progress of various schemes of the Department of Rajivika, Dairy and Cooperatives including Jal Jeevan Mission, PM Surya Ghar Yojana, Kusum Yojana, Pradhan

Mantri Ayushman Arogya Yojana, NREGA, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. While reviewing the preparations made in relation to heat wave in the district and health services and indices, he emphasized on effective implementation of nutrition programs. The Governor said that meaningful initiatives towards inclusive economic development are possible only when respectable employment and income opportunities are provided to every section of the society. He said that considering the spirit of 'work to every hand and income to every person' as the foundation of self-reliant India, we should effectively implement policies and schemes at the ground level. Appreciating the groups empowered through Rajivika and Cooperative Department schemes in rural areas, he said that work should be

done in this direction so that the light of economic empowerment reaches the last person of the society through these schemes. Bagde, while reviewing the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Rural), directed that housing should be provided to all eligible beneficiaries by publicizing the scheme. While giving instructions to ensure water availability in rural areas,

he directed to supply water through tankers in the dry zone. While reviewing the Jal Jeevan Mission, he directed the officials to ensure the reach of tap connection to every house in the district, as well as ensure their functional status and to ensure the availability of water by working under the scheme promptly in the remaining villages under the scheme.

Delhi High Court notice to Amanatullah Khan on petition against anticipatory bail

New Delhi: Delhi High Court has issued notice to Aam Aadmi Party's Okhla MLA Amanatullah Khan in the case of new FIR registered in the case of allegedly leading the attack on the police team in Jamia Nagar. This notice has been issued while hearing the petition of Delhi Police challenging the anticipatory bail granted to Amanatullah Khan by the trial court in this case. Justice Ravindra Dudeja's bench ordered the next hearing of the case on August 27. On February 25, Rouse Avenue Court granted anticipatory bail to Amanatullah Khan. Delhi Police had registered an FIR against Amanatullah Khan on February 11 in the case of leading the attack on the police team in Jamia Nagar. According to the police, Amanatullah Khan is accused of helping

fugitive accused Shabaz Khan to escape from police custody in the attempt to murder case. According to Delhi Police, the Crime Branch team had tried to arrest Shabaz Khan. Shabaz fled from the spot as supporters of Aam Aadmi Party MLA Amanatullah Khan allegedly clashed with the police team. The case filed by CBI and ED in the case of irregularities in recruitment in Delhi Waqf Board is being heard

against Amanatullah Khan in Rouse Avenue Court. ED arrested Amanatullah Khan on 2 September 2024. According to ED, Amanatullah Khan is the main accused in the irregularities in the recruitment of Delhi Waqf Board. On 1 March 2023, the Sessions Court of Rouse Avenue Court acquitted Amanatullah Khan in the case of obstructing the anti-encroachment drive of the Municipal Corporation in Madanpur Khadar area of South Delhi.



Governor Bagde also directed to give priority to construction of toilets at public places under Swachh Bharat Mission, ensure effective garbage collection and follow cleanliness standards. While reviewing the NREGA scheme being run by the Panchayati Raj Department, he directed to benefit eligible persons from the scheme. The Governor directed to conduct mass tree plantation across the district under Abhiyan Haryali-Rajasthan Rajasthan. He said that not only plantation, but solid arrangements should be ensured for the protection and proper maintenance of these trees for the coming years, so that every plant planted gets an opportunity to become a tree and the goal of environmental protection can be realized. Describing education as a powerful medium of human welfare, he directed to ensure the quality of schools and hostels. Bagde directed the Agriculture Department to make farmers more and more aware under the Soil Testing Program, so that they themselves get the soil of their land tested and can increase production and income by farming through scientific methods. He directed to benefit maximum number of farmers under Farm Pond, Crop Insurance Scheme. Governor Haribhai Bagde praised the innovative campaign of providing shelter to destitute cattle being run in the district and directed the officials to ensure proper arrangements of water, shade and fodder for destitute animals in summers. Clarifying the spirit of cooperation, he said that its objective is not profit or loss, but to make farmers and common people economically prosperous. This is the true success of cooperation.
