















# MGCU Guest Faculty' audio leak: Teacher Admits Bias Evaluation In Examination

Border News Mirror, however, does not endorse the 'validity and truthiness' of the viral audio, but it is being circulated on social media platforms on a large level drawing the comments and raising questions on the MGCU managements. Dr Sneha neither denied nor accepted her sound in the audio in her written message. The threats came after a group of students registered an oral allegations against Dr Sneha Chaurasia on March 4 and also wrote on April 21, 2025 causing

mass outrage among students and their parents. As varsity management failed to act on the allegations, the students came with the collective appeal against what they called "the highhandedness and dirty game of lady professors posted in MGCU on 21 April, 2025, which was, however, received by varsity management on 24 April this year. Amidst the continuous deterioration in the sacred and pious relations between Guru and disciple, this case has come to light from this Central University generating another row and heat. In the viral audio of the teacher, a shameful act of the teacher's distorted mentality including caste frustration has come to light, landing

university management in fresh controversy. It may be recalled here that this is not the first case in which MGCU has been shot in limelight for the wrong reason, but a few months ago a girl's students in the Hindi department leveled a serious charges of seeking sexual favour on her own professor in lieu of PhEd under his guidance. The written allegations are still gathering the dust in the vice chancellor office without any conclusions. Dr Sneha, who was contacted through whatsapp message, said that she is a local resident and she has nothing to do with these allegations, she said. Later on she deleted the message.

## 10 feet deep crater created by missile falling in a village of Phagwara, fire in the field

**Phagwara:** After the drone attacks being carried out by Pakistan in the border states of India for the last three days, now Pakistan has started attacking with missiles of higher mark capacity, which create deep craters several feet long after the explosion and its effect is being seen for several kilometers. A suspected drone or missile fell in the village Khalyan near Phagwara in Punjab on Saturday morning, causing a huge explosion and fire. According to initial reports, this incident took place in the field of Major Singh, a resident of the village, at around 2:40 in the morning. Eyewitnesses in the village said that two drones were seen flying in



the direction of Adampur shortly before the blast. One of these drones is believed to have fallen in the fields of village Khalyan, causing a fire and explosion, which sent the local community into a tizzy. The explosion created a crater eight to 10 feet deep and 12 to 15 feet

wide. The villagers acted immediately and put out the fire before it spread further using available resources. Fire department personnel later arrived at the scene and put out the fire. Despite the intensity of the blast, no casualties or injuries were reported. Residents of Phagwara

also heard a loud explosion during the night and saw drone lights in the sky. A blackout was imposed in Phagwara at around 2:15 am as a precautionary measure in response to the aerial activity. Local police from the Rawalpindi police station reached the spot more than an hour after the incident. Police sources have confirmed that further investigation is underway to ascertain the nature and origin of the suspected drone or missile. The area is under surveillance, and officials are monitoring any further developments. The incident has raised concerns about the safety of the airspace in the region and the possible source of flying objects.

## Pakistan is shielding its citizens to avoid retaliatory attacks, attacked India through 400 drones: Colonel Sophia

**New Delhi:** In retaliation to the Pahalgam terrorist attack, India has created havoc by running Operation Sindo on the terrorist bases of Pakistan. Giving information on the matter related to the attacks by Pakistan and the retaliation by the Indian Army on behalf of the Ministry of External Affairs, Colonel Sofia Qureshi said that Pakistan tried to launch missile and drone attacks on many cities of the country on Thursday night. In these unsuccessful attacks, some equipment and personnel were damaged at the Air Force bases in Udhampur, Bhuj, Pathankot, Bathinda. The military officer said that Pakistan used high-speed missiles at around 1:40 am last night to target the Air Force base in Punjab. India did not let these attacks succeed. Pakistani forces also attacked health facilities and schools. Wing Commander Singh said that India responded to these

nefarious acts of Pakistan by carrying out quick and well-planned attacks and accurately targeted the identified military targets. He said that Pakistani military establishments have suffered heavy damage in India's military action. He said that along with this, Pakistan is also continuously trying to spread malicious disinformation. It claimed to have destroyed India's major air defense system S-400 system, airports in Surat and Sirsa, which is completely false. He said that in the nefarious act of provoking war, soldiers of the Pakistani army have been seen marching towards the forward areas. He said that the Indian armed forces are fully prepared to give a befitting reply to any audacity of Pakistan. He said that the Indian Army is also responding to Pakistan's firing on the Line of Control and the International Border. He alleged that the Pakistani Army is deliberately targeting civilian areas and harming innocent people. Temporary restriction of air routes: As per NOTAM 3055/25 issued by the ICGS, 25 major air route segments falling under Delhi and Mumbai ICGS have also been closed till 5:29 AM of 15 May 2025. These routes will be temporarily unavailable from ground to unlimited

altitude. This is the national air traffic network, which will also have a direct impact on long-distance flights passing through North India and West India. At a time when there is tension on the border in Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab and Western Rajasthan, it is also possible that temporary flight restrictions have been imposed based on intelligence inputs. In this entire development, the government, the Ministry of Civil Aviation, the Ministry of Defense and the airlines will have to move forward with vigilance, coordination and transparency. The countrymen should show patience and cooperation, understanding this decision in the national interest.

**Dehradun:** All helicopter services going to Baba Kedarnath under Chardham Yatra have been stopped. All heli services have been stopped till further orders. The Uttarakhand government has also issued an order in this regard. According to the order of the Uttarakhand government, all helicopter services to Kedarnath, Badrinath, Gangotri, Yamunotri are closed. These services will remain closed till further orders. The move to shut down heli services during the Chardham Yatra has been taken at a time when tensions between India and Pakistan are constantly increasing on the border. There are continuous



attacks on Indian areas from Pakistan, to which the Indian Army is giving a befitting reply. Earlier, Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami had held a high-level meeting with officials. CM Pushkar Dhami, while sharing the photo on Twitter, wrote, "In view of the strict action being taken by India against terrorism, a high-level meeting was held in the Secretariat and the concerned officials were instructed to be fully prepared for every situation and to exercise special vigilance in the border areas as well as keep the administrative units deployed there alert. Instructions were given to ensure the availability of adequate life-saving medicines, surgical equipment and other essential medical resources in all the hospitals of the state. He said, the Food and Civil Supplies Department has been directed to ensure the supply of essential food items, ration and drinking water in the state. At the same time, relief and rescue teams have also been kept ready, so that prompt action can be taken if required. During the meeting, instructions were given to the Information Department to play an active role to avoid rumors and to give timely information to the public. For our government, the safety of the public is of utmost importance and we are ready to deal with any kind of emergency."
