लातेहार (एजेंसी)। लातेहार जिले के लिए आतंक का पर्याय बने जेजेएमपी के सुप्रीमो पप्पू लोहरा समेत दो नवसलियों को पुलिस मुठभेड़ में मार गिराया। बताया जाता है कि लातेहार थाना क्षेत्र के ईचाबार जंगल में शनिवार सुबह पुलिस और नवसलियों के बीच मुठभेड़ हुई। इस मुठभेड़ में झारखांड जनसंघ मुवित मोर्चा का सुप्रीमो पप्पू लोहरा और पांच लाख का इनामी नवसली सखानल कमांडर प्रभात गंगू मारा गया है जबकि एक नवसली घायल हुआ है। जिसे सदर अस्पताल में ड्लाज के लिए ले जाया गया है। वहीं सेट बन का जवान घायल हुआ है। उसका नाम अवधि सिंह है। घायल जवान को एयर लिफ्ट कर बाहर के राज अस्पताल में ड्लाज के लिए लाया गया है। जानकारी के मुताबिक लातेहार एसपी कुमार गोर के नेतृत्व में यह अधियान चलाया गया। इस अभियान में सोनारीएफ पुलिस की टीम शामिल थी। पुलिस को सुनान मिली थी कि पप्पू लोहरा अपने साथियों के साथ बड़ी बारदात करने की योजना बना रहा है।

सीजेआई प्रोटोकॉल उल्लंघन केस में कार्टवाई की याचिका खारिज

नई दिल्ली (एजेंसी)। सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने शुक्रवार को एक वकील की जनहित याचिका को खारिज कर दिया, जिसमें महाराष्ट्र के सीनियर अधिकारियों के खिलाफ कार्टवाई की मांग थी। याचिकाकर्ता का आरोप था कि इन अधिकारियों ने वीफ जस्टिस ऑफ इंडिया बीआर गवर्नर के पहले मुबाहिले दोरे के दोरान प्रोटोकॉल का उल्लंघन किया। मुख्य न्यायाधीश गवर्नर और जस्टिस ऑगस्टीन जॉर्ज मसीह की ओर ने इस याचिका को पलिसिटी इंटरेस्ट लिंगिंग नायर के अनुभव वाले याचिकाकर्ता वकील शैनेंद्र मणि त्रिपाठी पर 7,000 का जुर्माना लगाया, जो उन्हें लीगल सर्विसेज ऑर्पोर्ट में जाकरना होगा। सुनावाई के दोरान सीजेआई ने कहा, ये बहुत छोटा मामला है, इसे इन्होंने मैट्टेंड दोरे के लिए रखाना होगी।

Dr Prabhat Khetan made a Name For Himself In Medical World

MOTIHARI: Dr. Prakash Khaitan, a renowned neurosurgeon from Motihari, Bihar, has made a name for himself in the medical world with his exceptional surgical skills. His successful operation on a 12-year-old girl from Mirzapur, UP, who had a rare and complex 14 cm cyst in her spinal cord, has garnered international attention. The operation, which lasted 12 hours, was a huge success, and the girl is now leading a normal life. This achievement has been recognized by the International Book of World Records, and Dr. Khaitan's expertise in neurosurgery has been widely appreciated. He has previously set records in the Guinness Book of World Records and the Limca Book of World Records for removing 296 cysts from an 8-year-old girl's brain and a 240-gram tumor

from another patient's brain. Dr. Khaitan's dedication to his work and his ability to perform complex surgeries at a low cost have made him a respected figure in the medical community. His remarkable achievements continue to inspire and bring hope to patients and medical professionals alike.

News In Detail : The achievements of the country's renowned neurosurgeon Dr. Prakash Khaitan, a resident of Station Road, Motihari, have now started resonating on international forums. In the World Neuro Conclave 2025 held in March last, the successful operation of the biggest cyst ever inside the spinal cord of a 12-year-old girl of Mirzapur, UP and the successful execution of the rare and complex operation of bone transplant after a 12-hour marathon has become a topic of discussion in the medical world of the country and abroad.



The successful operation of the largest ever cyst of 14 cm in the spinal cord was registered in the International Book of World Records, setting a record. This 14 cm cyst in the 42 cm spinal cord of the girl had made the 12 year old girl disabled. She was not even able to tell when she had urinated or defecated, but now the girl is completely healthy and is leading a normal life. When other doctors of the country gave up on the

complexity of this operation, Dr. Prakash Khaitan successfully performed this complicated operation at a very low cost. In 2011 too, Dr. Prakash Khaitan was in the headlines when he got his name registered in the Guinness Book of World Records by removing 296 cysts from the brain of an 8-year-old girl. This achievement of his was also registered in the Limca Book of World Records in 2012. He got his name registered in the Asia Book of World Records in 2014 by removing a 240 gram tumor from the brain of Sabin Agarwal. The 296 cysts kept in the museum in Allahabad are a witness to the remarkable ability of Dr Khaitan. Dr. Khaitan did MS from King George Medical College, then after working as Consultant Surgeon at Fortis New Delhi is currently running Neuro Spinal Centre & Maternity Clinic in Allahabad.

Thakur inaugurated the Balai link road

Pradesh Education Minister Rohit Thakur on Friday inaugurated the two kilometer long Kelvi Balai link road constructed at a cost of Rs 55 lakh in Barthata Panchayat under Jubbal. It is worth mentioning that this road is a part of 'Kohlad Panchgaon Anti' road, the construction of which started in the 70s. With the passing of this road, the road construction work has been completed. Along with this, the foundation stone of the bridge to be built on Sojla-Kelvi-Gadavag road at a cost of two crore seven lakh rupees was also laid. Earlier, Rohit Thakur also inspected the work of upgradation and widening of Kohlada Anti road and the work of the Primary Health Center under construction at Batadgalu at a cost of 1 crore 70 lakhs. During this, a bus



was also flagged off on this road. Addressing the public meeting in Balai, he said that he has a family relationship with Barthata Panchayat and hence he is feeling very happy to inaugurate this road today. Because Balai is a remote place and despite being a part of Barthata Panchayat, it was not connected to Barthata. With the construction of this road, Barthata Panchayat has been completely connected to the roads. With the construction of this road, not only the residents of Barthata will be benefited but also



Thakur said that this entire area is an apple horticulture dominated area and from this point of view also this road is very important. With the construction of this road, the distance between Balai and Barthata has been reduced by about 35 kilometers, which will facilitate the gardeners in taking their produce to the markets and will also save time.

Himachal High Court handed over the investigation of Vimal Negi's mysterious death to CBI

Shimla, Himachal

Pradesh High Court has ordered the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to investigate the mysterious death of Vimal Negi, Chief Engineer and General Manager of State Power Corporation Limited. The court gave this order after accepting the writ petition filed by Mr. Negi's wife Kiran Negi. In the petition, the apprehension of the state police hiding the matter was expressed. While pronouncing the verdict, a single bench of Justice Ajay Mohan Goyal expressed deep concern over the manner of investigation conducted by the Special Investigation Team (SIT) constituted under Shimla Superintendent of Police Sanjeev Gandhi.

The court said that the



status report filed by the police indicated serious lapses and the suspicions raised by the family of the deceased had sufficient substance which required a CBI probe. The court ordered that no state cadre officer be involved in the CBI probe, so as to ensure a fair investigation. The verdict came on May 21 after nearly three hours of

heated arguments between Advocate General Anoop Ratan and former Advocate General R.K. Bawa, appearing for the family of the deceased. What emerged in the court was reprehensible, with Director General of Police (DGP) Atul Verma submitting a detailed report, pointing to an alleged systematic attempt to derail the investigation and

protect powerful persons.

According to Verma's report, the Shimla superintendent of police actively obstructed the investigation. He instructed the Special Investigation Team (SIT) officers not to share any records with the DGP and even prevented the forensic report from being sent to the director of the forensic department. Among particularly disturbing revelations in the report is that the pen drive recovered from Negi's body by ASI Pankaj on March 18 was formatted three days later. Later forensic tests revealed that the pen drive contained sensitive information related to two HPPCL projects - Kadcham and Pekhabela - indicating financial irregularities of

Strict action on increasing suicides of students in Kota, reprimanded the government; Police officer summoned

New Delhi,

The Supreme Court on Friday expressed deep concern over the increasing suicides of students in Kota city of Rajasthan. The court termed the situation as 'serious' and sought a response from the state government. A bench of Justices J.B. Pardiwala and R. Mahadevan directly asked the lawyer appearing for the state of Rajasthan, what are you doing as a state? Why are these children committing suicide and that too only in Kota? Have you not thought about this as a state? The court informed that so far this year, 14 cases of student suicide have been reported in Kota. The



lawyer replied that a Special Investigation Team (SIT) has been formed in the state to investigate the cases of suicide. The Supreme Court was hearing the case of the death of a 22-year-old student of IIT Kharagpur, who was found hanging in

his hostel room on May 4. Along with this, the court was also hearing the case of suicide of a girl student preparing for NEET in Kota. The bench questioned the four-day delay in filing an FIR (FIR) on May 8 in the case of the death of

an IIT Kharagpur student. The bench said, do not take these things lightly. These are very serious matters. The Supreme Court cited its March 24 decision, which took cognizance of the repeated cases of student suicides in higher educational institutions and called for the formation of a national task force to address the mental health concerns of students and prevent such incidents. On Friday, the bench reiterated that it is necessary to register an FIR immediately in such cases. The bench asked the concerned police officer present in the court, why did it take you four days to

register an FIR? The officer said that the FIR has been registered and the matter is under investigation. The bench directed that the investigation be continued as per the law. It came to light on record that the IIT Kharagpur officials had informed the police after getting information about the suicide, but the bench was not satisfied with the explanation of the IIT Kharagpur lawyer and the police officer. The bench said, we could have taken a very strict stand in this case. We could have also filed a contempt case against the police officer in charge of the concerned police station.

It has also been mentioned in the FIR that a video of the accused is going viral on social media, in which he is seen parking a Maruti company car on the middle of the road, getting down on the road and doing obscene acts with a woman on the 8-lane Delhi-Mumbai Expressway. BJP shrugged off the matter, Mahasabha removed him from the post.

Monsoon will knock at the earliest after 16 years! Will reach Kerala in the next 24 hours, farmers across the country will get relief

New Delhi,

. There is big news of relief for the people troubled by heat across the country. In the next 24 hours, the southwest monsoon is going to knock on the Kerala coast, and it is arriving about a week before its scheduled time. This will not only bring down the temperature, but will also clear the way for farmers to sow Kharif crops soon. According to the Meteorological Department (IMD), this is the first time after 2009 and 2001 that the monsoon is reaching Kerala so early i.e. in May itself. The normal date of arrival of monsoon in Kerala is 1st June, but this time it is going to enter the state before 27th May. The



state has been receiving heavy rainfall for the last two days, which is a clear indication of the progress of monsoon. The Meteorological Department has confirmed that the low pressure area and other favorable conditions are strengthening the entry of monsoon. According to Dhruv, in the coming days, the monsoon can

spread rapidly to the South and Central Arabian Sea, Maldives and Lakshadweep, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, Bay of Bengal and parts of Northeast India. A low pressure weather system is likely to form in the East-Central Arabian Sea, which may change the pattern of winds and rain on the western coasts while moving north. States like Maharashtra, Goa and Karnataka will benefit from this. The period of intense heat is continuing in many parts of the country. In such a situation, the early entry of monsoon is expected to increase the production of crops like paddy, maize, soybean, cotton and oilseeds. According to Dhruv, in the coming days, the monsoon can

Rahul Gandhi's troubles increased, court issued non-bailable warrant; ordered to appear on June 26

New Delhi, The legal troubles of Congress leader and Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi have increased. The MP-MLA Special Court in Chaibasa, Jharkhand has issued a non-bailable warrant against Rahul Gandhi and has strictly ordered him to appear in court personally on June 26, 2025. The court rejected the application for exemption from appearance filed by Rahul Gandhi's lawyer. The case is related to a political speech given by Rahul Gandhi in the year 2018. During a Congress session on 28 March 2018, Rahul Gandhi used harsh and allegedly objectionable words against the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). For this speech, BJP leader Pratap Katiyar filed a defamation case against Rahul Gandhi in t

he court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chaibasa on 9 July 2018. The case was later transferred to the MP-MLA Special Court in Ranchi on 20 February 2020 on the instructions of the Jharkhand High Court. Later when the MP-MLA court was established in Chaibasa, the case was transferred there. Despite the summons issued by the court, Rahul Gandhi did not appear. Due to this, a bailable warrant was first issued against him, but now a non-bailable warrant has been issued for not appearing. Rahul Gandhi's lawyer had sought a stay on this warrant in the Jharkhand High Court, which was rejected on 20 March 2024. After this, the petition for exemption from personal appearance in Chaibasa court was also rejected. Now the court has taken a tough stand and issued a non-bailable warrant and ordered Rahul Gandhi to appear in person on June 26, 2025. If he does not appear in court this time too, then more strict action can be taken against him.

Indore: Police have registered a case against a man from Indore, Madhya Pradesh for allegedly doing objectionable acts with a woman on the Delhi-Mumbai Expressway. This action has been taken after a video went viral on social media, in which the accused can allegedly be seen doing such acts in a public place. The accused has been identified as Manoharlal Dhakad, who is said to be a BJP leader. However, the BJP has denied this claim and said that the person seen in the video is not a primary member of the party. It is worth noting that the accused's wife is a BJP-supported district panchayat member. (RNS News Agency does not confirm the

Corona started scaring again! Cases of Kovid-19 increased again in many states including Delhi, government on alert mode

New Delhi,

An increase in Kovid-19 cases is being seen in the country once again. New infection cases have been reported in states like Gujarat, Haryana, Kerala and Karnataka including the national capital Delhi. In view of this, the governments have increased vigilance and advised the citizens to take precautions. The Health Department of Delhi Government has directed all the hospitals in the capital to remain on alert. Health Minister Pankaj Singh said on Friday that till Thursday, 23 new cases of Kovid-19 have been reported in Delhi. However, he said that there is no need to panic, because in most of the cases the symptoms are like common flu. The advisory issued by the government states that all hospitals should ensure full availability of beds, oxygen, medicines and vaccines to deal with COVID-19.



has ordered to send all COVID positive samples to Lok Nayak Hospital for genome sequencing. Also, daily reporting of data on the Delhi State Health Data Management Portal has been made mandatory. The advisory also states that hospitals will also have to monitor cases of influenza-like illness (ILI) and severe acute respiratory infection (SARI) and these will be recorded on the Integrated Health Information Platform (IHIP). Instructions have also been issued to upload all confirmed cases of COVID-19 and influenza in L-form. The government has indicated that the COVID-19 situation is being monitored and the public will be updated from time to time. All citizens have been appealed to wear masks in crowded places, maintain hand hygiene and get tested immediately if any symptoms appear.
