

The death toll in the Air India plane crash rises to 278, the process of finding bodies continues

Ahmedabad, Today is the fourth day of the Ahmedabad-London plane crash. The process of recovering completely burnt and mutilated bodies from the debris scattered at the accident site is continuing. According to the latest official information, the total number of people killed in this accident has increased to 278. Bodies are still being recovered from the Ahmedabad plane crash site. According to official information, the search for bodies is still going on. Three bodies were recovered from the wreckage of the crashed plane on Saturday, which were found from the rear part of the crashed plane. In this way, the total number of people killed in the accident reached 278. On Saturday, a girl and two



other bodies were found burnt from the rear seat of the plane above the mess of BJ Medical College. The girl is suspected to be a crew member of Air India. At present, the fire brigade team along with NDRF and other investigation agencies are investigating the accident site. Rescue teams are still searching for missing people around the accident site. It is feared that the death toll in

this accident may increase. Out of the total 241 passengers who died in the Air India plane crash, DNA samples of 19 passengers have been matched. DNA samples of 17 other deceased passengers are yet to be received. The process of matching DNA samples is going on continuously by a total of 36 experts at Ahmedabad Civil Hospital. The DNA matching process

is going on continuously for 24 hours. For the DNA matching process, samples are being tested in batches for 36 to 48 hours. The process of matching DNA samples of 3 foreigners and one Indian citizen among the deceased is pending. After the passengers, the biggest loss in the plane crash was suffered by the junior doctors of BJ Medical Campus. It is feared that even on the fourth day of the plane crash, 17 junior doctors are missing. About 100 people were burnt in the fire in BJ Medical Hostel in the plane crash, including 36 junior doctors. Even four days after the incident, four junior doctors are admitted in the ICU. At present, a total of 200 ambulances are ready in the civil campus to transport the bodies to their

homes. Each ambulance will be operated by the police. The families of those killed in the Air India plane crash are worried due to the delay in getting the bodies. It is taking time to match the DNA samples. This is done as per a process. People allege that the administration is not giving a satisfactory answer in this regard. Many family members are pleading in anger to hand over the body soon. Due to the changed atmosphere in Ahmedabad on Saturday night, the rescue work going on at the site of the incident was also affected for some time. So far no official announcement has been made regarding the last rites and handing over of the body of former Chief Minister Vijay Rupani.

PM Modi leaves on a visit to 3 countries including Canada, will participate in G-7 summit

New Delhi, Prime Minister Narendra Modi left today on a five-day visit to three countries. The Prime Minister is scheduled to visit Cyprus first. He will participate in various programs during his visit. The most important event in this visit of PM Modi is to attend the G-7 summit in Canada. PM Modi said on Sunday that the G-7 summit to be held in Canada will provide a platform for exchange of views on important global issues and priorities of the Global South. Ahead of his three-nation visit, PM Modi said he is looking forward to



interacting with the leaders of partner countries during the summit in Kananaskis, which he is attending at the invitation of Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney. The Prime Minister said that during this visit he will thank the countries that supported India in its fight against terrorism. Along with this, he will make efforts to promote mutual understanding to end terrorism. The Prime Minister said that he will visit Cyprus on 15-16 June at the invitation of President Nikos Christodoulides.

Cyprus is a close friend and important partner of the Mediterranean region and the European Union. During his visit to Cyprus, he will try to further strengthen the relations between the two countries. He will hold talks on trade, security, investment, technology and other issues. PM Modi said that after the G-7 summit, he will visit Croatia and hold meetings with President Zoran Milanovic and Prime Minister Andrej Plenkovic. The Prime Minister said that relations between India and Croatia are old and close.

School admission festival will start from tomorrow in Chhattisgarh, CM appeals to public representatives to participate

5 people died in Amethi road accident; were going to Bihar with dead body from Haryana, collided with pickup

Amethi, 5 people died tragically in a horrific road accident on Purvanchal Expressway on Sunday morning. All the people were going from Haryana to Bihar carrying a dead body. Their ambulance collided with a pickup going ahead on the road. In this accident, all the five people in the ambulance died. While one person is injured. Police reached the spot and sent the bodies for postmortem. The accident took place near 59 km point on Purvanchal Expressway in Shukul Bazar police station area of Amethi district. The deceased have been identified as Rajkumar Sharma alias Satish son of Ashok Sharma, resident of Ram Bhadrapur, Police Station Kalyanpur, District Samastipur, Bihar. Ravi Sharma son of Balram resident of Ram Bhadrapur, Police Station Kalyanpur, District Samastipur Bihar, Sarfaraz resident of Nalhar Haryana, Abid son of Hamid



resident of Ferozepur, Police Station and District Nuh Haryana, Phulo Sharma son of late Ram Prasad Sharma resident of Ravi Tola, Police Station Hathauri, District Samastipur Bihar. Shambhu Rai son of Yogeshwar Rai resident of Puri Nahi, Police Station Waris Nagar, Samastipur Bihar is injured. According to the information, these people were going from Haryana to Bihar with the dead body. Ambulance HR 74 B 2657 hit the pickup UP 71 BT 3957 from behind. Due to this, 5 people travelling in

the ambulance died. One person got injured. Among the dead are two ambulance drivers and three other people who were carrying the dead body. The pickup driver also suffered minor injuries. The police reached the spot and admitted the injured to the local CHC for treatment. The police have identified the bodies of the deceased. Their families have also been informed. SHO Shukul Bazar Abhinesh Kumar said that legal action is being taken after informing the families.

Instructions given to ensure cleanliness of schools and other necessary preparations for school entrance festival

Korba, A review meeting of the education department was held in the Collectorate hall under the chairmanship of Collector Shri Ajit Vasant. He reviewed the departmental work in detail and gave necessary guidelines to the officers. The collector, while taking information about the preparations for the school entrance ceremony for the new academic session, directed the departmental officers to ensure necessary preparations including cleanliness of all schools before June 16. Along with the school entrance ceremony, he also directed to distribute caste certificates of children taking admission in school for the first time from Anganwadi. The collector said that breakfast distribution will be started in schools from July 01 after the school opens. For this, the officers were asked to complete the necessary preparations within the stipulated time period. Also, he directed the officers to prepare and submit new proposals for the distribution of breakfast and the arrangement of gas cylinders in schools. He said



that from this academic session, the honorarium of the cooks preparing breakfast and food in schools will be increased to Rs 1000 per month. In the meeting, the collector, while taking information regarding the rationalization proceedings done in the district, directed the officials of the education department to inspect all the cases with petitions as per the order of the High Court and ensure their resolution by the committee. 100 feet tall mobile tower fell in Delhi's Safdarjung Enclave, major accident averted

New Delhi, A 100 feet tall mobile tower collapsed due to a strong storm in the B-2 block of Safdarjung Enclave, one of the poshest areas of the capital Delhi, on Sunday morning. The accident happened around 4 o'clock, when most of the people were in their homes. It was fortunate that no one was present on the road at the time of the accident, otherwise there could have been a big loss. Local people said that this tower was installed without their permission. Initially they were told that street lights were being installed, but later a mobile tower was installed here. Due to the fall of the tower, many trees and electricity wires in the area were damaged. We had also protested to prevent the installation of this tower, but women police were called to remove us. They said that if this pole had



fallen during the day, a major accident could have occurred. He said that till 9 am no officer or employee reached the spot, nor was any attempt made to remove the tower. As soon as the information of the incident was received, Aam Aadmi Party leader Somnath Bharti from Malviya Nagar reached the spot. He made serious allegations against the BJP government and said that all the departments

in Delhi are under the BJP, yet such accidents are happening. The local people tried a lot to prevent the tower from being installed. Despite this, this tower was installed, which is a big example of negligence. This tower has been installed over the drain. If this tower had fallen during the day, how much damage would have been caused. The government will have to answer for this.

People badly burnt in Kedarnath helicopter crash, DNA test will be done for identification

Rudraprayag, Helicopter accidents are happening continuously in Uttarakhand. So far this year, 5 helicopter accidents have happened. In which 13 people have lost their lives. This morning also, a helicopter returning from Kedarnath met with an accident. 7 people including the pilot died in this heli accident. The accident was so terrible that the bodies were badly burnt. In such a situation, now DNA test will be used to identify the bodies. The bodies have been badly burnt in the helicopter crash in Gaurikund, Kedarnath.

In such a situation, only a DNA test will tell whose body it is? which the identity, kinship or disease of any person can be ascertained. When the condition of a dead body is so bad that the face or body cannot be identified, then DNA is taken from the body. After which it is matched

Korba-Urga main road is in dilapidated condition, if it is not repaired before the rains then problems will increase

Korba, The approximately 200 meter long road right in front of the police station on Korba-Urga road has become dilapidated. Big potholes on the road have put traffic in danger, due to which there is a constant risk of accidents. This road comes under the Public Works Department. Local citizens and drivers have demanded the repair of this road before the onset of monsoon. The Public Works Department and the District Administration have been informed several times by the regional police and social organizations considering the seriousness of the matter. According to the information, the condition of potholes on this road has



become so bad that it has become difficult for two-wheeler and small vehicle drivers to pass through here safely. Incidents of vehicles slipping and falling are happening every day. Local people say that the attention of the concerned department has been drawn towards this for a long time, but no concrete action has been taken so far. If the repair work is not started soon, the situation may worsen during the rainy season, which may lead to serious accidents. Local citizens and public representatives have demanded from the administration that this road should be repaired as soon as possible so that the common people can get relief and possible accidents can be avoided.
