

Foreign Minister S Jaishankar's three-day visit to China, will attend SCO meeting

New Delhi, External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar will leave for a three-day visit to China from Sunday. He will attend the meeting of foreign ministers of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) member countries to be held in Tianjin. Foreign Minister Jaishankar has met his Chinese counterpart several times on the sidelines of international meetings. But, this will be his first visit to China after bilateral relations came under strain following the violent clash in the Galwan Valley between the troops of the two countries on the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in June 2020. An important bilateral meeting between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chinese President Xi Jinping took place for the first time in almost five years during the BRICS



summit in the Russian city of Kazan in October 2024. Prime Minister Modi had said that the foundation of India-China relations will be mutual trust, mutual respect and mutual sensitivity. It is important to keep these three key points in mind to maintain positive and sustainable

relations. Since then, National Security Advisor (NSA) Ajit Doval, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri have visited Beijing to hold in-depth discussions on a number of complex issues. Addressing the 20th meeting of Security Council Secretaries of Shanghai

Cooperation Organisation (SCO) member states in Beijing last month, National Security Advisor Ajit Doval said India is deeply concerned about the continued threat from United Nations Security Council (UNSC) designated terror groups such as Lashkar-e-Taiba, and the country's Foreign Minister.

Patna, Leader of Opposition in the Assembly Tejashwi Yadav has again raised questions on Sunday regarding the law and order situation in Bihar. New Delhi, President Draupadi Murmu has nominated 4 new members to the Rajya Sabha using powers conferred under sub-section (a) and clause (3) of clause (1) of Article 80 of the Constitution. The names include former Foreign Secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla, Ujjwal Devrao Nikam. These appointments have been made to fill the vacancies caused by the retirement of nominated members. According to the notification (SO 3196 (E) issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, it was announced on 12 July 2025. The nominated members include Ujjwal Devrao



Nikam, C. Sadanandan Master, Harsh Vardhan Shringla and Dr. Meenakshi Jain. The objective of these appointments is to ensure representation of experts and eminent persons from various fields in the Rajya

Sabha, as provided in the Constitution. Under Article 80 of the Constitution, the President is empowered to nominate persons to the Rajya Sabha who have made special contributions in the fields of art, literature, science, social service and others. These appointments are considered important to infuse diverse viewpoints and expertise in the Upper House of Parliament. The role of nominated members is to make significant contributions to legislative discussions and enrich deliberations on issues of national interest. Ujjwal Devrao Nikam, C. Sadanandan Master, Harsh Vardhan Shringla and Dr. Meenakshi Jain are known for their remarkable work in their respective fields. In particular, the appointment of Harsh Vardhan Shringla is being considered important on the basis of his diplomatic

experience, while Dr. Meenakshi Jain is known for her scholarly contribution in the field of history and culture. Nikam is known for fighting the case against Ajmal Kasab. He had strongly advocated for the death penalty for Kasab, the only person caught alive in the 26/11 Mumbai terror attack. These newly nominated members are expected to make a positive contribution to the Parliament with their expertise on national and international issues. This move also reflects the government's commitment to involve experts from diverse fields in the legislative process.

Tamil Nadu: Goods train carrying diesel caught fire, many trains affected

Tiruvallur, A freight train derailed and caught fire near Tiruvallur railway station in Tamil Nadu on Sunday morning. According to initial information, this freight train was carrying diesel or crude oil. Following the incident, several express trains on the Tiruvallur and Arakkonam routes headed towards Chennai Central have been halted mid-way, causing huge inconvenience to passengers.
