Something in heart, something else on tongue, Mayawati taunts Rahul Gandhi

Lucknow, While 'apologizing' to the backward society, Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi admitted that Congress and he personally did not work as much for the backward classes as should have been done. He has called it his mistake. Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) national president Mayawati reacted on this issue. She said that the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha admitting that Congress has not been up to the mark in getting the backward society their rights is nothing new, rather it seems more like a selfish politics like saying something in the heart and something else on the tongue. BSP chief Mayawati wrote in a post on the social media platform X on Saturday, "The Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha admitting



that the Congress party has not been up to the mark and trustworthy in matters of political and economic hopes, aspirations and getting the constitutional rights including reservation of the people of the country's huge population of Other Backward Classes (OBC) is nothing new, rather it seems more like a selfish politics like saying something in the heart and something else on the tongue." In fact, his statement is as well known as the Congress party's sad and unfortunate attitude towards the millions of exploited, deprived and neglected SC/ST community of the country and due to which the people of these classes have ultimately had to form their own party Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) here due to their self-respect and self-esteem and the desire to stand on their own feet. Mayawati wrote, Overall, as a result of this, the Congress party is continuously out of

power in major states of the country including UP and now after losing power, they have started remembering these classes, which can be called crocodile tears if not crocodile tears due to their intentions and policies always being flawed, whereas in the current situation, the BJP's NDA also seems to be adopting the same double standard attitude towards these classes. India will keep an eye on every movement on Earth, ISRO-NASA will launch the world's most expensive satellite 'NISAR' on this day

New Delhi, India is ready to take another historic leap in the field of space. The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) and the US space agency NASA (NASA) will jointly launch their most ambitious mission 'NISAR' on July 30, 2025. NISAR, i.e. NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar, is the world's most expensive and advanced earth-observation satellite that will keep an eye on even the tiniest changes on the earth's surface 24x7. This much-awaited satellite will be put into Earth orbit through the ISRO-SN16 rocket from Satish Dhawan Space Center in Sriharikota. ISRO



Chairman Dr. V. Narayanan recently confirmed this launch during an event in Telangana. The biggest feature of NISAR is its dual frequency radar technology (Ru-band and S-band), which enables it to take very accurate pictures of the earth in all weather conditions, day or night, even amidst clouds and rain. It can capture even the slightest changes in the land as small as 1

centimeter. This unique ability will prove to be a milestone in predicting natural disasters like earthquakes, volcanoes, landslides and tsunamis. This technology can be a lifesaver, especially for sensitive areas like the Himalayas. This mission is not just limited to disaster management but also has the potential to revolutionize the Indian agriculture sector. NISAR will provide accurate data on soil moisture, crop health and groundwater levels. This information will help farmers plan crops, better manage irrigation and prepare for situations like drought or floods. Apart from this, it will also study the effects of climate change, such as melting of glaciers and rise in sea level. This mission is an excellent example of the growing space partnership between India and the US. ISRO has designed the S-band radar, satellite structure and launching vehicle (rocket) for this mission. At the same time, NASA has provided the Ru-band radar and a huge mesh antenna of 12 meters diameter. This mission not only demonstrates India's technological prowess and self-reliance, but also further strengthens its position as a major space power on the global stage.

TERRORISTS KILL POLICE OFFICER IN PAKISTAN'S KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA

Islamabad, Terrorists in Pakistan killed a police officer in Karak district of the troubled province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on Friday. Apart from this, the police foiled a late night attack on a police station in Basyakhel area of Bannu. According to the news of Dawn newspaper, Karak police officials said that the terrorists shot the police officer in a remote mountainous area. After this, they fled towards the mountains. This police officer was going to his hometown Chapai Banda. Security forces have intensified the search for the terrorists involved in the murder of the police officer. The last salute was given to this officer in the Karak City Police Line. After this, the body was taken to Chapai Banda for last rites with respect.



Police officials said that a terrorist attack on a police station in Basyakhel area of Bannu district was foiled late on Thursday night. The attackers used sniper rifles and lethal weapons. The attack was carried out at around 1:35 am with the intention of capturing

the police station. After an hour-long gunfight, the attackers were forced to flee. Hours after this incident, terrorists in Bannu used a quadcopter drone to target a police post in Majanga area. Ammunition was dropped on the roof of the post building from a quadcopter.

Nepal hopes to sign the delivery treaty during Prime Minister Oli's visit to India

Kathmandu, The Nepal delegation, which returned here after attending the Home Secretary level meeting held in New Delhi, has said that there has been an agreement on mutual legal assistance and delivery treaty between Nepal and India. The delegation has expressed hope that it will be signed during the proposed visit of Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli to India. Nepal's Home Secretary Gokarna Mani Duwari told media persons on Saturday that as a result of long-term efforts, the delivery treaty between India and Nepal has been finalized. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is preparing to sign this treaty during Prime Minister Oli's proposed visit to India in September. Nepal's Home Secretary said that for the last several years, there was a dispute between Nepal and India on some issues regarding the



delivery treaty, on which an agreement has been reached in the meeting held in New Delhi this time. The objective of this treaty is to enhance the exchange of information on cross-border crime, terrorism and economic terrorism, support investigations and prosecutions and facilitate the extradition of criminals. At present, due to the absence of a surrender treaty between the two countries, there is always a dispute over the extradition of criminals. The Nepal delegation

Tanvi Sharma, Vennala Kalagotla win bronze medals in Badminton Asia Junior Championship

New Delhi, India's campaign in the Badminton Asia Junior Championship ended on Saturday with the defeat of Tanvi Sharma and Vennala Kalagotla in the women's singles semi-finals in Solo, Indonesia. Both Tanvi and Vennala won bronze medals. For the first time in the history of the competition, India has secured two women's singles medals in the same edition. In the first semi-final between two unseeded players, China's Si Ya Liu defeated Vennala 21-15, 21-18 in 37 minutes. Liu took a 14-7 lead in the first game, but Vennala reduced the gap by winning 8 of the next 11 points. However, Liu won the first game by winning 4 consecutive points. The second game was also a close contest, with the score at 15-14 before Liu surged ahead and eventually converted her fourth match point to seal a place in the final.



In the other semifinal, junior world number one Tanvi Sharma made some unforced errors at crucial moments and paid the price for it as she lost to 8th seeded Chinese player Yin Yi Qing 21-13, 21-14 in 35 minutes. Tanvi was level at 13-13 in the first game but Yin, ranked 73rd in the junior world rankings, won 8 consecutive points to take the lead. The 16-year-old Indian, who made headlines after finishing runner-up in the US Open Super-300 tournament last month, took a 6-1 lead in the second game but Yin made a comeback to trail by one point at half-time. The Chinese player soon overtook Tanvi and then without looking back, started preparing to face her compatriot Liu in the final.
