

आमिर खान की बहुप्रतीक्षित फिल्म हुई बंद

आमिर खान पिछली बार फिल्म 'सितारे जमीन पर' में नजर आए थे, जिसे दशकों और समीक्षकों द्वारा खूब सराहा। फैस उनकी अगली फिल्म का बेसब्री से इंतजार कर रहे थे, लेकिन उनके अगले बड़े प्रोजेक्ट को लेकर निराशाजनक घबबट सामने आई है। रिपोर्ट्स के मुताबिक, आमिर की बहुप्रतीक्षित फिल्म भारतीय सिर्फ़ाम के जनक दादा साहेब फाल्के की बायोपिक अब बंद कर दी गई है। पहले आमिर निर्देशक लोकेश कनणराज के साथ एक सुपरहीरो फिल्म करने वाले थे, जिसमें उन्होंने उनकी फिल्म 'कुली' में कैमियो भी किया था। लेकिन 'कुली' के बॉक्स ऑफिस प्रदर्शन के बाद यह प्रोजेक्ट रोक दिया गया। अब वही हाल उनकी बायोपिक फिल्म का भी काम रोक दिया गया है जिसे लेकर वे खुद बेहुल उत्साहित थे।

हिरानी और आमिर का बड़ा फैसला- रिपोर्ट के अनुसार, आमिर खान और निर्देशक राजकुमार हिरानी ने मिलकर इस प्रोजेक्ट को बंद करने का फैसला किया है। 'सितारे जमीन पर' के बाद से आमिर की किसी नई फिल्म का इंतजार लगातार बना हुआ है, लेकिन अब तक वह कोई नई स्क्रिप्ट फाइनल नहीं कर पाए हैं। कई चर्चाओं और बैठकों के बाद भी बात आगे नहीं बढ़ सकी। सूत्रों के मुताबिक, दादा साहेब फाल्के की बायोपिक बंद करने की मुख्य वजह इसकी स्क्रिप्ट ही रही। हिरानी और आमिर, जिन्होंने पहले '3 इंडियां' और 'पीके' जैसी ब्लॉकबस्टर फिल्मों में साथ काम किया था, इस बार भी एक मजबूत कहानी पेश करना चाहते थे, लेकिन कई बार स्क्रिप्ट लिखने के बावजूद वह कहानी वैसी नहीं बन पाई, जैसी उम्मीद की जा रही थी। दोनों ही कलाकारों का मानना है कि कंटेंट की क्वालिटी किसी भी प्रोजेक्ट से ज्यादा मायने रखती है इसलिए अदृश्यी या कमजोर कहानी के साथ आगे बढ़ना सही नहीं होगा।

जलदबाजी नहीं करेंगे आमिर- बताया जा रहा है कि आमिर खान अब अपनी अगली फिल्म का ऐलान तभी करेंगे, जब उन्हें एक स्टाइक और दमदार स्क्रिप्ट मिलेगी। वह जल्दबाजी में कोई प्रोजेक्ट साझन नहीं करना चाहते। हालांकि उनके इस फैसले से फैसला निराश हो सकते हैं, लेकिन आमिर और हिरानी तभी दोबारा साथ आएंगे, जब उनके पास दर्शकों को मनोरंजन और संदेश दोनों देने वाली कहानी होगी।



'हक' में किरदार को निभाने में मुझे दिवकत नहीं हुई: वर्तिका सिंह

बॉलीवुड एक्ट्रेस वर्तिका सिंह ने कोर्टलम द्वारा फिल्म 'हक' के जरिए बॉलीवुड में कदम रख दिया है। फिल्म हक को लेकर वर्तिका ने बताया कि उन्हें फिल्म के सेट पर अपने किरदार को निभाने में काफ़ी दिक्कत नहीं हुई।

वर्तिका ने अपने सह-कलाकारों, स्टास्टर इमरान हाशमी की जमकर तारीफ की। उन्होंने कहा, "मुझे इमरान हाशमी के साथ काम करते हुए किसी तक हक का स्टारडम का दबाव महसूस नहीं हुआ। वह बहुत ही जमीन से जु़ड़े और सहयोगी कलाकार हैं। वे हर किसी को समान महत्व देते हैं, जिससे नए कलाकारों को आत्मविश्वास मिलता है। उनके सहज रखने की वजह से मैं अपने किरदार को बेहतर तरीके से निभा पाई।"

वर्तिका ने यामी गौतम के साथ काम करने के अनुभव को भी खास बताया। उन्होंने कहा, "यामी के जयादातर सीन इमेशन से भरे हुए थे, इसलिए सेट पर मजाक-मस्ती का होती थी। अब हर सीन से पहले अपने किरदार के भावों में पूरी तरह उत्तर जाती थीं। मैंने उनसे बहुत कुछ सीखा, खासकर भावनाओं की

गहराई बनाए और छोटे-छोटे हावधार के जरिए अभिनय को प्रभावशाली बनाने का तरीका।"

अपनी अभिनय का साफ़ा के बारे में बताते हुए वर्तिका ने कहा, "मैंने साफ़ा की मानसिकता और भावनाओं को समझने के लिए कविताएं लियीं और उसके अंतीम, पाठ्य-पाठ्य और जीवन की परिस्थितियों पर जोड़ से तैयार किए।

इसने मुझे किरदार की कंटिलानाओं को गहराई से महसूस करने में मदद की।"

फिल्म 'हक' की कहानी शाह बानो के क्षेत्र से प्रेरित है। इसमें यामी गौतम ने शजिया नाम की महिला की भूमिका निभाई है, जबकि इमरान हाशमी उनके पाते के किरदार में हैं। वर्तिका द्वारा जिमाई गई शाही शादी कर लेती है, जिससे बाद एक कानूनी जंग शुरू होती है। इस फिल्म का निर्देशन सुपर्फ़ वर्मा ने किया है।

Rajnath blames Marxist historians for neglecting Dalit, tribal contributions

New Delhi, Agency: Defence minister Rajnath Singh on Sunday blamed Marxist historians and the previous governments for deliberately neglecting contributions of Dalit and the tribal communities as he unveiled the statue of freedom fighter Uda Devi Pasi in Lucknow.

He said contributions of only a select few families in the freedom struggle were included in history books. "Dalit, Adivasi [tribal] and Pasi leaders were neglected," he said. Singh criticised the previous governments for overlooking the contribution of Pasi leaders in the freedom struggle.

"[Uttar Pradesh] chief minister Yogi Adityanath has given recognition and honour to such leaders of the freedom struggle," said Singh. He listed the contributions of Pasi leaders in the struggle.

Adityanath said Uttar Pradesh was the focal point of the 1857

revolt against the British and that Pasi leaders, including Uda Devi, contributed a lot to it. Adityanath cited steps his government has taken to inform students about the history and contribution of the Pasi community in the freedom struggle. "A separate book has been introduced in primary schools on the leaders of the Pasi and other communities who were neglected."

Empty claims': Chirag Paswan refutes Jan Suraj's 14,000 crore 'World Bank funds diverted' claim

New Delhi, Agency: Union Minister Chirag Paswan dismissed on Sunday the claims made by Jan Suraj's spokesperson Pavan Varma about the central government "diverting" funds from World Bank for the Bihar Assembly elections.

While reacting to the allegations, Paswan questioned where Varma got his information from and labelled his claims as "empty".

"Where do they get this data from, this information from... Making empty claims - if you have any facts, present it and the Govt will respond," news agency quoted Paswan as saying.

Varma added that Bihar's public debt currently is around 4,06,000 crores and the interest per day on it

is 63 crores.

"Just an hour before the model code of conduct was implemented, 14,000 crores were withdrawn and 10,000 each was allocated to 1.25 crore women..." Varma said.

"As I have said, this is our information. If it is wrong, I seek forgiveness. But if it is true, then the question arises as to how far this is ethical," he added.

Varma also claimed that there were rumours circulating in Bihar that the remaining amount would not be released if it was not voted to power.

SIR in West Bengal: Kolkata's Sonagachi sex workers demand inclusion in voter list

Kolkata, Agency: Sex workers in Kolkata's Sonagachi area are urging the government to include their names in the voter list as the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process begins in Bengal. Many sex workers fear being left out due to a lack of documentation, with some having no connection with their parents or original homes.

The Durbar Mahila Samanwaya Committee, an NGO working for sex workers, has submitted a written appeal to the Chief Electoral Officer, West Bengal, demanding special verification camps within Sonagachi. They're proposing on-site registration drives, allowing sex workers to self-declare their residence with NGO or peer verification.

Secretary of the Durbar Mahila Samanwaya Samiti, Sonagachi, Bishwakar Laskar, urged the government to enrol the names of sex workers in the voter list.

Speaking to ANI, she underlined that most of them (sex workers) are not in touch with their families, since they left their homes years ago.

"Sex workers are facing problems with the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) because not everyone has their documents. This is because many have left their homes and have no connection

with their families... Our demand is that it would be good if the names of sex workers are included (in the voter list) based on the documents they have..." she said.

Furthermore, she highlighted that the sex workers received their Voter ID Card in 2002. Only after that did they start voting.

"Sex workers received the official voter ID cards in 2002... Prior to that, they had no voter ID cards... We began exercising our voting rights after 2002... Naturally, our name won't be present in the 2002 voter list..." she said.

Laskar stated that now several sex workers have official documents such as Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Ration Card, etc. She urged the government to consider these documents.

"Now some people have documents like Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Ration Card, Passport, electricity bill, etc... We urge the government to add their names in the SIR on the basis of these documents, it will benefit the community..." she stated.

She outlined that the committee has sent a written application for at least 12,000 sex workers at Sonagachi brothel, out of which 8,000 reside here and the rest 4,000 fly for work regularly... These sex workers are facing a lot of issues, that's why we have sent the letter to the



Electoral Commissioner... We are waiting for a response..." she said.

The Election Commission has assured that special measures are being taken to ensure that all eligible citizens are included.

'As a proud Hindu Shashi Tharoor reacts to Assam minister's 'gobi farming' post



Assam, Agency: Amid the controversy over minister Ashok Singhal's "Bihar approves Gobi farming" post, Congress MP Shashi Tharoor weighed in after he was tagged by a user in a reply to the original post. Notably, social media users were shocked to see the "gobi farming" post by the Assam minister, who also received some backlash online.

One of the users, @isaipatel on X, replied to Singhal's post, saying that a cabinet minister, no less, is "glorifying the massacre of 116 Muslims to celebrate an election victory". He tagged Tharoor and asked if the senior Congress leader could get a few influential Hindu leaders to condemn this "normalisation of one of the worst pogroms perpetuated against Bihar Muslims".

The Congress MP then responded to this post, indirectly replying to the Assam leader's "gobi farming" post. Tharoor said that he is not a community organiser, so joint statements are not his job.

"But as a passionate advocate of InclusiveIndia and a proud Hindu, I can speak for myself, and for most Hindus I

know, in saying that neither our faith nor our nationalism requires, justifies or condones such massacres, let alone applauds them," he added.

What does the "gobi farming" post mean?

The photo, many users on social media

said, is linked to the "cauliflower burial case" or the Logain massacre, an incident

that took place during the Bhagalpur communal riots in 1989 in Bihar.

Did Shashi Tharoor condemn the post?

While the Congress leader said that his faith does not require, justify or condone such massacres, one user replied to him asking if he condemned the "gobi farming" post.

The X user said, "But you didn't say you condemn it." Responding to him, Tharoor said, "That's exactly what I did! I condemned it."

Heavy rain likely in parts of Tamil Na-du Chennai; IMD issues orange alert



Chennai, Agency: The Indian Meteorological Department predicted light to moderate rainfall at isolated places in Chennai and Tamil Nadu on Sunday. The rainfall prediction is triggered by a low-pressure area being formed over the southwest Bay of Bengal, off the coast of Sri Lanka.

According to IMD warning, heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at isolated places over Villupuram, Chennai, Chengalpattu, Cuddalore, Mayiladuthurai, Nagapattinam, Tiruvarur of Tamil Nadu and Puducherry & Karaikal area.

For tomorrow, IMD said that heavy to very heavy rainfall can occur at a few places over Chengalpattu, Kancheepuram, Villupuram, Puducherry, Thoothukudi, and Kanyakumari districts.

Orange and yellow alert issued

An orange alert has been issued for today in Tamil Nadu's Pudukkottai, Thiruvarur and Mayiladuthurai. While a yellow alert has been

sounded in Thoothukudi, Madurai, Nilgiris and Sivagangai, among other places.

A yellow alert has been issued for the entire Kerala, according to the Met Centre Thiruvananthapuram warning.

Last month, widespread rain lashed Chennai and other parts of Tamil Nadu. Meanwhile, Deputy CM Udayhdi Stalin inspected the infrastructure development of the state and renovation works being undertaken in the south Chennai area to improve the waterways, PTI reported.

The warning said that under the influence of upper air cyclonic circulation, a low-pressure area was formed over the Southwest Bay of Bengal on 15 November. Heavy rainfall in these regions is likely due to this low-pressure area. It also forecasted squally weather and wind speed reaching 35 kmph to 45 kmph to prevail along and off the Tamil Nadu coast. Further, fishermen are advised not to venture near sea areas during these days.

electors out of the 50,97,43,173 printed, covering regions - Andaman and Nicobar, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Gujarat, Kerala, Lakshadweep, Madhya Pradesh, Puducherry, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.

Over 5.33 lakh Booth Level Officers (BLOs) and 10.41 lakh Booth Level Agents (BLAs) have been deployed. With 6.41 crore electors.

Tamil Nadu has distributed 5.90 crore forms, achieving a 92.04% coverage. Uttar Pradesh, the state with the highest number of electors (15.44 crore), has attained distribution of 94.37%. In contrast, smaller regions, such as Goa and Lakshadweep, achieved 100% distribution. Form distributed in Gujarat - 98.58%; Madhya Pradesh: 98.38%; Rajasthan: 97.32%; West Bengal: 98.08%; and Puducherry: 93.88%. Only Kerala, at 87.54%, remains below the 90% mark.

Currently, a nationwide SIR phase two is being carried out in 12 states and union territories, with the final elector's list to be published on February 7, 2026. According to the Election Commission, printing and training took place from October 28 to November 3, followed by an Enumeration Phase from November 4 to December 4.
